



### 34 NISEI KILLED IN ACTION

Secretary of War Stimson announced last week that 34 Japanese American soldiers of the 100th Infantry Battalion of Gen. Mark W. Clark's Fifth Army had been killed in action in Italy to date. The Secretary of War also announced that 130 were wounded and five are missing.

### CIVIL SERVICE

To create an additional list of eligibles for Federal employment, a U. S. Civil Service Examination for stenographer and clerk typists will be held on Saturday afternoon, December 18, for qualified applicants.

### PRESIDENT BANS DISCRIMINATION IN GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS

Termining racial discrimination against workers as "detrimental to the prosecution of the war", President Roosevelt has ordered that all Government contracts made with private manufacturing or service firms shall carry a clause barring racial discrimination in hiring employees.

Under the terms of this order, all persons contracting with the

Government will be required to adhere to this clause which prohibits discrimination against any employee of applicant for employment on account of race, creed, color, or national origin. Sub-contractors as well as principal contractors, must comply with this clause.

The President issued such an Executive Order some time ago; this order was interpreted by Comptroller General Lindsay Warren as being a directive and, therefore, not mandatory. In a letter addressed to Attorney General Francis Biddle, however, the President made it clear that the order was mandatory and must be incorporated in all Government contracts.

### T.B. CHRISTMAS SEALS ON SALE AT RED CROSS OFFICES

This year the community is again being urged to purchase Christmas seals to help in the fight against tuberculosis.

The seals, picturing a little girl waiting for Santa Claus, are

selling at the Unit Red Cross Offices for one cent each.

One-half of the proceeds will go to the state tuberculosis fund, while the remainder will be used to combat the disease here.

## IMPROVEMENTS SEEN FOR HIGH SCHOOL

One of the weakest points in the present system of Poston's Educational system is the inadequacy of instructional equipment and supplies, according to a correspondence from Dr. O. K. Garretson, High School Visitor for the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, to Dr. A. L. Harris Poston's Director of Education. The High School Visitor had made a survey of the conditions of the Poston schools when he had been in Poston recently, and made several suggestions concerning improvements and changes before Poston schools could be accredited by the Association which he represented.

In his letter he gave his opinion of the efficiency of instruction and the general intellectual and moral tone of the schools as being quite satisfactory. The school plant, when completed will meet minimum requirements, but there are certain facilities, such as showers, which could

"General Mark W. Clark reports that the 100th Infantry Battalion composed of Americans of Japanese ancestry, continues to make a highly creditable campaign record. These soldiers are well trained and disciplined and fight with confidence and resolution.

They are particularly skillful in scouting and patrolling and are cheerful and uncomplaining, and their rate of illness is practically nil."

be much more satisfactory. His letter stated above, there is also a crying need of instructional equipment and supplies.

He approved of the library facilities and the school records and reports.

"I was very favorably impressed with the young teachers that you have brought into Poston this year and I hope that if vacancies occur you may be able to add persons of similar caliber to your staff," Dr. Garretson said in the letter.

Dr. Harris stated, "We are moving in every way that we know to place qualified teachers in positions of instructional responsibilities in order that we may meet the requirements for accreditation, insofar as teaching staff is concerned.

"Construction of adequate shower facilities for Physical Education classes is starting immediately in Postons II and III," continued Dr. Harris. "A request for approval of addition of similar facilities to the High School plant as Poston I is being made. We appreciate the evaluation which Dr. Garretson has given to us and believe that we shall be able to make the changes recommended for meeting the requirements for accreditation."
