

## AMPHITHEATRE FINISHED IN 3

Construction of the Unit III amphitheatre started a month ago and which seemed to have been forgotten, was again brought to life with block carpenters and construction workers under the supervision of F. Hayakawa, working endlessly and zealously on its construction and Unit III electricians wiring the stage despite the heavy wind, was completed in time for the New Years all unit drama performance staged here last Saturday and Sunday evening.

The amphitheatre located between the firebreaks of Rows I and III have a 40' x 40' stage with 5 feet wide aisles on both sides and built on concrete foundations.

Just behind the stage is the 25' x 40' dressing room which is walled with plaster board. A small upstairs portion is built where actors will be situated.

Many portions of this theater are temporary, including the "hana-nichi" as work on this project was rushed.
