

## MORE ACTIVE DUTY ORDERS ARRIVE IN CENTER FOR BOYS

### Pvt. Shintaku, Unit II Soldier Wounded in Action *Call is for June 7*

A wire disclosing the fact that her youngest son, Pvt. Bob Kiyoshi Shintaku of the 442nd Infantry, was slightly wounded in action at Italy on May 18, was received by Mrs. T. Shintaku of Blk. 219-2-C, from Acting Adjutant General Dunlop Thursday morning.

Reports of his condition will be sent as they are received, the wire stated.

Immediately following a short furlough with his family here, Bob left with the 442nd

Infantry for overseas duty last February.

Upon induction into the army a few days before the outbreak of the war in December, 1941, Pvt. Shintaku was in airplane mechanic at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, before the camp was designated for the All Nisei Combat Unit.

Prior to induction, Pvt. Shintaku resided in Salinas, where he attended school and operated a service station.

Seven more boys, the second group of inductees from the center, have been ordered to report on Wednesday, June 7 to Fort Douglas for active duty assignments, according to James D. Crawford, selective service representative.

Their names are: George Shiba, 309-9-D; Takashi Ezaki, 12-12-A; Haruji Akimoto, 5-9-C; Mitsugu Eto, 209-5-B; Tetsu Henry Nakabayashi, 5-6-D; Arthur Tetsu Sugino, 11-8-B; and William Masaru Shigekawa, 21-11-C. Of this list, the last two are not on the project, Sugino having left recently for Chicago and Shigekawa having relocated to Virginia.

Also received late this week were about 80 names for induction and pre-induction examinations, which are tentatively scheduled for about June 24. This will be the fourth visit of the army medical team.

Sgt. R. L. Porter of the Phoenix board notes that several residents have written to the Phoenix board about possible deferments. It is again emphasized that all such matters should be brought to the attention of their original local boards.

### LEAVES FOR UNDER 18 CLARIFIED

Seasonal leaves may be issued to any person under 17 years of age and to anyone under 18, who became 17 on or after May 17, 1944, according to an emergency instruction received from Washington. The applicant must meet the eligibility requirements for indefinite leaves.

The minor must be accompanied by a parent or have the consent of the parent or guardian, and the project director, relocation officer and high school principal must agree that he is reasonably mature before he will be issued a seasonal leave, the instruction states.

All persons under 18, whether accompanied by parents or not, must be certified by a physician as physically fit for employment before recruiting.

The trial of George Fujii, local mortician who has pleaded not guilty to the charge of violating the wartime sedition act, has been set for Tuesday, June 6 in Phoenix, Project Attorney Scott Rowley reports.

Herman Lewkowitz will represent Fujii as attorney.

## SACRAMENTO PANTHERS CAPTURE POSTON II SOFTBALL CROWN

The champions, piloted by vociferous George Kuwabara upon the departure of former manager Swissy Hironaka, slugged their way to the Poston II Aye softball crown last Monday by downing the heretofore undefeated Block 219 Clippers, 7-6 in a final deciding contest; thus closing the season without a defeat.

The Panthers were again forced to come from behind to cop the title as the favorite Clippers went into an quick 4-0 lead in the initial stanza.

The scrappy title-bound Panthers were not to be denied.

In the ensuing inning, league's most valuable player, Jim Namba of the Panthers, walloped the offering of opposing chucker Wacky Wakayama for a round-tripper, followed immediately by Phil Matsuo with a duplicating homer to cut the lead 4-2.

Both teams remained scoreless 'til the sixth, when the Panthers knotted the score on triples by George Yamada and Jim Namba and a single by Toots Hironaka. But the determined Clippers regained the lead,

by annexing another in the seventh.

It was the champions turn in the eighth. With their chips down, they clustered four successive hits and a sacrifice for three runs.

T. Hironaka slapped a double after first batter P. Matsuo popped to second. Winning pitcher Sabby Namba followed with a single scoring Hironaka. Namba advanced to third on Hip Matsuo's double to center and reached home with a tying run on K. Matsueda's perfect squeeze bunt; Matsuo advancing to third. A moment later still with only one out, Mits Yamada laid a bunt to first, allowing Matsuo to scamper home with the winning run. Paul Kuwabara ended the inning by flying out to deep right field.

The Clippers nearly tied the score in the final frame as J. Tanimura who reached second on Panthers' lone error was caught at the home plate in a close play attempting to score on T. Higashiocka's single.

The Panthers hammered Wakayama for 14 blows including two homers, two doubles and two triples.

Jim Namba slammed a homer, triple and a single in five trips to the plate followed by Hip Matsuo with two singles and a double in four trips.

Winning pitcher Sabby Namba limited the losers to 8 safeties.
