The State Department reports that there is no restriction upon the exportation of human ashes to Japan. Although there are no means of exporting oshes to Japan at the present, in the future if there is an exchange ship, it will be possible to send ashes by it.

interested Persons in this matter should communicate with the Spanish Consul. Ashes, which are to be sent, should be placed in a container that can be readily opened for inspection by customs officials since inspection of baggage and property of enemy aliens is necessary.


