"FISHERS OF MEN"

An inspiring message delivered on August the 8th--has put a new zeal into our lives to do more for our Master in bringing souls to the Lord.

A few pointers in his message: From Genesis the first chapter, we find the verse, "Let there be light". "Light is a thing of beauty; it is significant of visibility; it produces life; and makes our bodies strong and healthy. Darkness is the absence of light; it will cause one to die out if one does not have the Light of Christ. Christ is the --- Light of the World.

"Take the bidding of Christ. II Corin. 4:6 & Matt. 14:18--22. 2000 years ago, our Lord, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two fishermen, called to them saying, 'Follow me and I will make you fishers of men'. The men left their nets and followed after His bidding.

"Let us obey the Lord Jesus Christ, the captain of our lives. The captain is the one who takes us through to our destination. He knows all about navigation and the crew have to trust him.

"We cannot afford to steer our lives or we will find trouble. Put your trust in Him.

"The Holy Spirit is the Mastman who spots souls for Christ." Mr. Nakagawa told of his experience as a fisherman on board his father's tuna clipper, relating how the mastman spots a school of tuna, the steps taken to get the tuna into the net and the process in pulling the prize into the boat, and the return of the joyous fishermen.

"But there are admonitions..if we get snags in the net, there will be disappointments. The nets have to be examined every time to see that there are no holes and to see that it is strong enough.

"In our Christian life, we must create time to have quiet hour with the Lord; read the Word of God; quench not the Spirit; and ever be watchful not to grieve the Lord.

"We are commissioned to go out and bring souls to Christ.
"Your labor will not be vain in the Lord."
