SUNDAY SCHOOL ROOMS

The Granada Christian Church Sunday School is deeply grateful to Mr. Paul J. Torry, Superintendent of Education, to Dr. Enoch Dumas and Mr. Herbert K. Walther, principals, for graciously opening Torry Hall and class rooms for our Sunday School use. At present, our work is centered in the 8H school zone, with the exception of Issai Bible Classes.

Incidentally, the Sunday School is solely responsible for the upkeep of each room we use. Therefore, it is requested that each teacher and pupil take good care of school properties. Our record has been excellent thus far.

 Intermediate girls, seventh and eighth grades, 1B; ninth grade, 1G; Intermediate boys, seventh and eighth grades, 2D; ninth grade, 1D.  
 High school girls, 11E; High school boys, 11D  
 Colloge age class, Torry Hall.  
 Issai Bible classes, 7H and 10H, Recreation Halls.

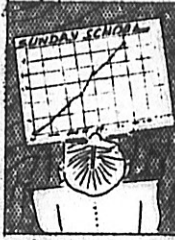
The addresses of the committee members have been listed for the benefit of those who wish to contact them with any Sunday School problems.

Our Thanksgiving offering together with the young people's Thanksgiving offering will go to tubercular patients and other bed-ridden people.

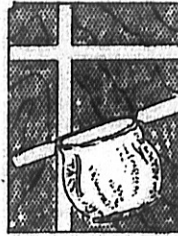
**CHOIR AND ORCHESTRA**
