SECURITY AND CHARITY  
The problem of providing continued subsistence to the aged isseis will occupy a unique niche in the annals of old age security in our country. It is a problem which WRA now is facing and it is a problem which established government agencies, including the Social Security organization, will confront in the next 10 or 20 years or more.

There is no gaining saying the fact that a majority of isseis are headed for some form of relief even had the evacuation not taken place. But it is difficult for the authorities to come up with adequate answer to the question that had evacuation not taken place, most isseis would not have been reduced by circumstances to the point of requiring public relief. With the closing of the camps, therefore, this is a primary problem in education which the WRA will have to put over among the isseis. The alternate may be to maintain one or two camps for the duration.
