AUBURN OFFICIALS DISCLOSE CONFESSION FROM SUSPECTED DOI RANCH MARAUDERS

Auburn, Calif.—Placer county authorities announced Feb. 3 they had confessions from James E. Watson, 38, and Pfc. Elmer Johnson, 20, AWOL from the Army post at Oakland, to the attempted looting and dynamiting of the packing shed on the ranch of Sumio Doi. Dist. Atty. C. E. Tindall said Watson's younger brother, Charles, is wanted for almost two weeks with hardly a lead on the identity of the marauders, the officers got their first clue during the questioning of an intoxicated man who had 25 sticks of dynamite purchased for \$1 and a gasoline stamp from Johnson.

Permanent Commission

Washington, D. C.—Representative Helen Gahagan Douglas (Calif.) and Charles R. Clason (R. Mass.), today introduced bills to establish a permanent five-man fair employment practices commission. The permanent FEPC would have the power to rule on all charges of racial and religious discrimination in private industry. The present FEPC has jurisdiction only over war plants. A similar bill was approved by the House Labor Committee last year.
