SITUATION CALLED "TENSE" BY COUNCIL

New York City in designating Feb. 13 as Racial Relations Sunday, the Federal Council of the Churches of Christ outlined the issues and declared that the current race relations is "tense".

Some of the issues announced by the council were: that "non-white" races who constitute the vast majority of the human race, are rightly third of the attitudes of superiority of those who, though racial minority, control the governments of the world.

The resettlement of Japanese Americans taken from their homes, the Oriental exclusion acts, are among the domestic problems that cry out for Christian treatment, the council said.

"We must substitute pride in the human race for racial pride," the announcement emphasized.

JACL ISSUES MONTHLY REPORTER FOR MEMBERS

Salt Lake City—The Pacific Citizen, official publication of the JACL, has largely been devoted to disseminating news about Japanese Americans. With the request of many JACL members to know more about detailed operations of the national organization and activities of the various chapters, the National JACL Conference held in Salt Lake City last December authorized the "JACL Reporter" as a monthly bulletin to be issued to members only.

The January number, first issue of the "JACL Reporter," is now being mailed to all active and associated members of the JACL.

Commission Would Set Up Fair Employment Boards

Washington, D. C.—Senator Taft (Rep.) of Ohio Monday introduced legislation to establish a federal fair employment practice commission.

The proposed five-member commission would be authorized to set up regional boards "to make comprehensive studies in each district to determine how discrimination in that district on grounds of race, creed and color can best be eliminated and full employment be provided for Negroes and all other minority groups," Taft told the senate.

Larger Benefits Seen

Larger benefits for those now insured and additional protection for 20,000,000 additional workers, not now insured, are among the recommendations made by the Social Security Board in its annual report to the Congress.

F. Fehr, manager of the board's Denver office, said that if the board's proposals should become law they would meet the desire of many self-employed persons, small businessmen and professional men and women who do not have social security insurance protection.
