On The Other Hand—

NOT UNEXPECTED

When the evacuee delegates met recently in Salt Lake City, they were moderately winded and dined by the resettled townfolks, they put in time to whip through a set of recommendations to the Authority. But apparently they "found no time" to meet with the officials of the JACL headquarters in that city.

A curious fact on the surface; but not an unexpected thing, although disappointing.

Desperate today are the people whom the delegates represented, along two lines, get out of the camps and relocate before the WRA employees do; and ridding themselves of the nearly three years' accumulation of false sense of security and indolence. And the cleavage between most of the evacuees and the League, which developed following the evacuation, still persists.

We would suggest now that the cooling-off period is over. The wisest action which the evacuees could take now is to shake hands with the league and to support, and at the same time, to solicit the aid of that nation-wide nisei organization. Whatever the grudge of the individual evacuees against the league, the issue at hand calls for just such a help as the JACL is capable of rendering.

RED CROSS DRIVE

March 9 to 23 has been set aside for the Red Cross fund drive to raise \$735,000 for the great international relief organization.

Never in the world's history has so far-reaching an effort been made to alleviate suffering, to back up our fighting men, and at the same time meet domestic emergencies and disasters.

Hunt Cooks Staging Sit-Down Strike

Hunt, Ida.—A sit-down strike of more than 35 evacuee cooks at the Japanese Relocation center here today has thrown this project completely out of the window.

Harry Stafford, project director, "The trouble here," Stafford said, "is really a nuisance strike which came quickly upon the heels of a directive to close three mess halls on or before Feb. 28 and reduce the stewards force by 225 on March 1."

There are 2700 still employed at the project and all who are late for work will get paid for just what they do, regardless of what new trick these chefs think up. There are 1400 employed in the stewards' forces at the center.

The statement advised that the proposal has brought adverse criticism, but the report said: "We believe our views are patriotic."

MAY INVESTIGATE HOOD RIVER POST

Indianapolis—National American Legion headquarters announced today that the names of Japanese-American soldiers were back on the honor roll of the Hood River, Ore. Legion post.

The Oregon post removed the names Dec. 2 on grounds the men were of "dual allegiance." The action drew censure from National Commander Edward M. Schellinger, who ordered that the names be restored.

One name was not restored because the serviceman had been dishonorably discharged.

BACK ON ROLL

Salmon, Ore.—National Legion Commander E. N. Schellinger may demand an investigation of the Hood River, Ore., post for paying 16 Japanese-American names from the county honor roll, a national committee said Monday.

O. E. Palmiste said such an inquiry might result in the post losing its charter, if the offense is judged that serious.

FBI CHIEF STATES HIS POSITION

Fresno, Cal.—Replying to an inquiry from the Fresno Bee as to the truth of statements that the FBI "clears" evacuees who are returned to California, J. Edgar Hoover, director of the FBI, last week denied his department certifies to their loyalty.

Hoover replied: "The FBI makes no recommendation whatever as to whether any Japanese ancestry should return to the West Coast. This is a matter entirely within the jurisdiction of Army and Navy officials. It is their business to be satisfied that the WRA camps prior to their release. It is not the business of the FBI to make such a recommendation."

The FBI does, upon request from the War Relocation Authority, furnish a work sheet of its files for any information which might be available concerning any particular individual who is being considered for return to the West Coast. This information is furnished only to the War Relocation Authority and is not to be disseminated to any other agency without its recommendation.
