POINT-BY-POINT REPLY

MADE BY WRA TO EVACUEES'

21-POINT RECOMMENDATION

Washington, D. C.—Point-by-point comments by the WRA on the 21-point recommendation made by the evacuee delegates at the recent Salt Lake City all-center conference indicate a generally encouraging support of the wishes of the evacuees; with reservations, where clearly under its authorization, the WRA cannot add a recommendation.

For example, on one of the recommendations, the Authority assured evacuees that the agency is exploring agencies which would provide care for property losses; and shows the proper method for filing the several types of damage claims.
