REPEAT PATTERN

"The exclusion of each group, in turn, merely resulted in the importation of some other group when the next emergency developed. Thus, the exclusion of the Chinese was followed by the influx of the Japanese; the exclusion of Japanese by the importation of Negroes; and the exclusion of Mexicans by the influx of the so-called 'Okies' and 'Arkies.' The same pattern is being repeated today (in California). For the evacuation of 110,000 persons of Japanese descent has been a factor in stimulating the influx of more than 200,000 Negroes,"—Carey McWilliams in PM.
