Lee Puts Blame On "Little Hitlers"

Chicago—WRA Relocation Officer H. Rex Lee from Wash., D. C., told members of the City Club last week a "small but well-organized economically interested group of Little Hitlers" are profiting from a commercialized campaign aimed at 2,000 returnees to the West Coast. Too many merchants, he said, have anti-Japanese signs in their windows because they are afraid to take their out. Too many people have signed anti-Japanese resolutions because they were afraid not to "play ball." Too many produce men have refused to buy mis-grown vegetables because they were told other markets would then be closed to them, Lee said.

ASK HIGH COURT TO HEAR CASE

Cheyenne, Wyo.—Whether or not nisei detained at relocation centers are subject to induction under the draft law, was the question that has been submitted to the U. S. Supreme Court for decision last week by the Civil Liberties Union in behalf of Mineo Tamura of Heart Mountain. The petition seeks to review the decision of Federal Judge T. Blake Kennedy, who imposed a three-year sentence on Tamura and 62 other Heart Mountain evacuees.

PRESIDENT SIGNS BILL TO ASSIST EVACUEE RESETTLERS; TRANSFER \$175,000 FUND

Wash., D. C.—Pres. Harry S. Truman signed on April 26 a deficiency bill authorizing the transfer of an additional \$175,000 from WRA funds to the Social Security Board's resettlement assistance program.

Accelerated resettlement, following revocation of exclusion order has exhausted the \$50,000 originally set aside to provide additional assistance.

Honor Hood River Hero

Hood River, Ore.—Hood River—where the American Legion Post was spurred by the National Legion in restoring names of Japanese-Americans expunged from its war honor roll—today had a Japanese-American hero.

He was Frank T. Hachiya, technician third grade, Hood River native, who posthumously was awarded the silver star medal for gallantry in action on Leyte.

New York City—Japanese in America should actively strengthen American democracy inasmuch as America will play a vital role in the new Far East; and one means to aid in establishing a democratic political system in Japan is to inform the American public of the long-standing struggle waged by Japanese people against their military dictators.

These were the two conclusions reached at the recent Issei session of Holan Kai of the JACD.

Springfield, Ill.—The Illinois Senate voted unanimously May 2 to create a special committee to investigate the sources of anonymous circulars, letters and pamphlets containing statements calculated to create hatred of racial and religious groups. Lt. Gov. Hugh W. Cross named the committee. Many of the circulars were directed at the civil employment practice bill now pending in senate judiciary committee.
