RECONSIDERATION ASKED OF MYER

Reiteration of the original request for reconsideration and the offer of unequivocal assistance was lodged at the door of WRA in the letter last week to Dilon Myer, in Washington, from the Japanese-American Citizens' Association, Chairman S. Hidemitsu Topaz, Utah, of the all-center evacuee representatives' headquarters.

The letter, as it was conferred in Salt Lake City, also forwarded recommendations to Mr. Myer, and receives his comments. This letter from Topaz, though a sequel to his previous letter, does not contain the record for consideration of the original evacuee delegates' petition.
