DOUBLE FEDERAL CHARGE ON DYNAMITERS

San Francisco—Federal charges of illegal possession of dynamite will be brought against James E. Watson, bartender, and his brother, Charles Watson, rancher, for dynamiting of Sumio Doi's property, U. S. Attorney Frank J. Henney announced July 24.

With two AWOL soldiers, they were acquitted in a state court last April of the same charges. Henney said the government will not seek indictments against the soldiers. Watson brothers will be charged with two counts: conspiracy to possess dynamite and illegal possession of dynamite. Maximum penalty for the first count is two years in Federal penitentiary and a \$10,000 fine, for the second, one year and \$5,000.
