## DEMOCRAT MAY TRY TO Citizens ADD TWO PARTY PLANKS Urged to

Washington, D. C.—The racial equality issue, which already has caused a rebellion among some Southern Democrats, may give the resolutions committee at the Democratic National Convention one of its biggest headaches.

Senator Dennis Chavez, D., N. Mex., has introduced, asserted recently that he is going to try to add two planks to the Democratic platform: First, for a permanent Fair Employment Practice Commission; and second, for a continuation of the good neighbor policy in Latin America.

"The Republicans beat us to the punch," Chavez said, alluding to the GOP planks denouncing racial discrimination, poll taxes and other pro-House measures in the South. "I think the Republicans have some strong minority planks. I hope the Democrats have some just as good or stronger."
