"Many times we have been asked whether our policies favor return to the Pacific coast or resettlement to other areas. The only answer we can give is, 'Come back,'" said, "that is this depends on the welfare of the individual evacuee."

NISEI LINGUISTS TRAINED
AND BEING SENT TO JAPAN

Between Nov. 1, 1940 and May 31, 1945, 20,861 enlisted nisei were sent to the service. Of these, 17,717 were taking 79 nisei girls, WRA Asst. Director R. B. Cozzens told Salinas, Cal., peace officers at their conference.

During the same period, 162 Japanese Americans were commissioned as officers.

Language schools up to last July 1945 and sent overseas, 2,078 enlisted nisei. As of that date, 717 were scheduled to be sent overseas in August and 1,156 were in training, awaiting assignment; with an additional 1,250 being produced for such training.
