UNEASY OVER DOMINION BILL

Toronto, Ont.—The Dominion government will probably seek to revoke nationality of and deport Canadian citizens of Japanese origin. The Bill No. 15, to be called the "National Emergency Powers Act, 1945," contains a clause extending the Government's power over "entry into Canada, exclusion and deportation and revocation of nationality." It is directly concerned with the more than 10,000 persons of Japanese origin who have signed "voluntary" registration forms.

Propose To Exclude Evacuees In Valley

Albuquerque, N. M.—A 1000 landowners have formed an organization in Mesilla Valley in southern New Mexico to present "voluntarization" of the valley by Japanese and have called on the state attorney general to see that the state land law is enforced. A 1000 others are expected to sign up.

The king and queen were going to visit the United States in May, 1942. Field officers here went to claim for the graduates. A crew, consisting primarily of nisei, even translated the Japanese plan for the use of the Philippines long before U. S. forces landed on Leyte.
