NISEI EXPATRIATE GOES TO JAPAN TO BE CONVINCED HE SHOULDN'T HAVE GONE

Uraga, Japan—Tom Satohi Yoshizawa, 37, Lake Cal, expatriate who used to be an American but didn't like it, is back in Japan today at his own request but now in a conviction completely he should have stayed in San Francisco.

In this dreary reception center, crowded with Japanese re-entrants from the United States, the Pacific Islands and Singapore, he says disgustedly: "I never realized it was as bad in this country as it is. Please do me a favor and send a message to other Japanese in the United States who are thinking of coming to Japan. Tell them my name and I urge them to stay where they are."

Yoshizawa, who was born in Sakai, Japan, 27 years ago, was within one-half year of being graduated from San Francisco State Teachers' College when he broke out. He was put in the Santa Anita camp.

"I recognized my United States citizenship because I felt I was being pushed around," declared Yoshizawa, who had visited Japan three times before the war. "I had always thought I should be on an equal basis with Caucasian fellows. I felt even though many times before I had run into the color barrier, I could not even get a swimming pool in San Francisco."

"Then when the time came along I felt sure democracy did not apply to me, because of the way I was treated. That hit me because I had always considered myself a good American. I had been a Boy Scout, Future Farmer, member of basketball captain—then all of a sudden I was shunned."

Housing Shortage Hits Returns To Hawaii Honolulu—Of the total of 169 families of Japanese ancestry, comprising 911 individuals, who returned here recently on the U. S. Army Transport Shawnee, 59 families, it was learned, are now housing facilities awaiting them in the islands.

Indications are that 44 of the 99 homeless families were not living in the territory when the war started and 55 families lived in the territory before the war but have lost their housing accommodations during their absence.

GOVERNMENT SPENT \$237,000,000 IN WARTIME CARE OF 112,000 EVACUEES

San Francisco—A total of \$237,000,000 was spent by the Federal government in the four-year wartime care of 112,000 evacuees, it was disclosed yesterday as the WRA cleared last week's accounts.

WRA Director Dillon Meyer, it was disclosed, has recommended that the Federal Government recognize "bona fide claims" suggesting that Congress should set up a special claims commission to sift such claims by evacuees and approve those deemed worthy.
