MORE WORK AHEAD FOR MEN OF U. S. 10TH CORPS

Mindanao, Philippines—U. S. Army 10th Corps language detachment in the Philippine liberation campaign of Leyte and Mindanao translated approximately 2,500 captured enemy documents and interrogated 1,000 Japanese prisoners.

CHARGE SPYING ON SHIPS IN 1941 ON COAST

Washington—Vice-Admiral T. S. Wilkinson, the Navy's intelligence chief in 1941, revealed Monday that Japanese spies were checking on ship movements in Seattle and Bremerton, Washington; San Diego and Long Beach, Calif. before the Pearl Harbor attack.

This revelation by the naval officer came during his testimony before the Pearl Harbor investigating committee. He did not elaborate further on the circumstances under which the Japanese were spying on United States ship movements at these West Coast harbors.

TRUMAN'S FEPC STAND AROUSES ANTAGONISM

Washington—President Truman's actions with Congress in having been strained as the result of his having (1) issued an order authorizing the Federal Relocation Authority committee to investigate and report on employment practices in private industries until next June 30, (2) returned of U. S. employment service to the states within 100 days, (3) termed unacceptable a house substitute for the so-called "full employment" bill passed by the senate.

Representative Gibson of Georgia and many other southern congressmen aroused particularly by the FEPC directive. They have been constant critics of the agency and forced a cut in its funds last spring. They said the president's move to extend FEPC's wartime authority might prompt a new effort to abolish it. Bills are pending in both chambers to establish the agency on a permanent basis.

INDUCTION OF FATHERS DROPPED

Washington, Dec. 19—The induction of fathers was dropped Tuesday by national selective service headquarters. Fathers, including prospective nisei inductees, with fewer than three children will be permitted to volunteer, however.

The discontinuance was ordered in telegrams sent to all state selective service directors. They were told to advise all local boards to end the processing for induction or assignment of any registrant who has one or more children.

Ask Prime Minister To Drop Reparation

Winnipeg, Canada—Petitions, containing signatures of 20,000 persons, asking for reparation to Japan and asking the government that they be permitted to remain in Canada, were forwarded recently to Prime Minister Mackenzie King, Minister of Justice L. S. St. Laurent, and Minister of Labor Humphrey Mitchell.

FORTAS THINKS DISTRICT AIDED PEARL DISASTER

Washington—Undersecretary of Interior who expressed his belief that the district of Japanese-Americans living in Hawaii contributed to the Pearl Harbor disaster by causing military officials to concentrate on protection against sabotage.

He pointed out the irony of the measures, since no sabotage occurred in Hawaii, and since Hawaii's nisei, including the 100th Battalion, made a glorious war record. Fortas expressed the belief that it is time Americans learned the lesson "that racial fear and hostility can blind us to realities, even military realities, and can endanger our national existence."

Tule Lake Segregation Center Not Happy Place

Seattle—Current issue of the American Friends Service Committee newsletter reports that although 14,000 people of Japanese ancestry still remain in Tule Lake center, no schools are provided for the children. "Tule Lake is not a happy place," "regardless of the mistakes on both sides, the children are not to blame, and they should not be hurt and distressed," the report stated.

ASFC collected thousands of Christmas gifts for relocation centers, articles requested readers to send presents for Tule Lake children and young people up to 18 years to Seattle office. "We can do a lot for you and a lot of harm that has been done to these people."
