## RETURNS TO SOUTHLAND WELCOME XMAS

Los Angeles—Home-coming for millions of veterans—and thousands of American Japanese—finds "no room at the inn".  
Relocation from WRA centers to emergency shelter in hotels, barracks and trailers at Camps, has been completed except for a few thousand still at Tule Lake to be relocated during January. But another job of relocation—to permanent housing—remains and finding suitable employment along with the WRA's task for its remaining months. To do this, "direct-action" Housing and Employment committees will be set up very soon.

It is good to see that tolerance has been achieved in Southern California. There is no bitterness toward Nisei or Issei; instead, a genuinely friendly attitude prevails. No do the Issei and Issei feel resentment toward those who removed them from the camps in the spring of 1942—removed them despite their being loyal Americans.

After almost 20 centuries, the words of the Master take on a tremendous practical meaning. The New Year may see a new order of real brotherly love.

Among those grateful—are the relocated from the WRA centers. For many of them have only the barest necessities of life. The good folks of El Centro, recognizing this, are providing Christmas parties for nisei children, and food baskets for needy families of Japanese ancestry.
