By the logic of age average, which still sticks close to the "almost," or early 20's, a very sizeable portion of niseis may be expected to see service before the war ends.

Something like one-sixth of Japanese Americans already are in the army, with many more to follow them. The present total is 10,000.

Post-war reconversion of soldiers into civilians is a problem worrying the American people today. To say that the nisei soldiers automatically confront their reconversion period than their Caucasian brothers-in-arms, would be a distortion of the problem.

Col. William C. Menninger, chief of the Division of Neuro-psychiatry of the office of Surgeon General, has been pondering this general problem. Restlessness and indecision, he says, will be their primary symptoms; coupled with their philosophy of life from day to day with no sense of responsibility for anybody else.

The colonel thinks that their greatest problem will be the shattering of illusions. It is difficult to say, off hand, just how much illusions the average nisei soldier carries with him into the army and through the battles.

Opinion might be ventured to the extent that, considering their background, perhaps they do not carry as much illusion as the average Caucasian soldiers. Perhaps.
