PROGRESS OF WAR WATCHED

It is not yet known, of course, whether any Japanese Americans are among the troops scheduled for the succeeding waves of invasion forces attacking in France. There have been, so far as is known here, no information about nine units stationed in England. Of course, this does not preclude their presence on British Isles.

To date, it appears that all, or most, of the Japanese American troops in combat have been sent to fight against the Nazis in the Italian campaign now nearing climax as the Anglo-American forces approach it was Secretary of War Henry L. Stimson who steadily backed the loyal Japanese Americans' right to enter the Army; and it was he and the War Department officials who conceived plans for the Japanese American combat units.

Following the line of thought frequently expressed by responsible officials in the nation's capital, it may safely be presumed that many Nisei will see action in Europe before

long. Except for the specialized tasks—mainly those of interpretive and translation work for which Nisei are being trained and used in the South Pacific campaign, authorities frequently have intimated that the Japanese American combat soldiers may not be used in that particular theater of war. This, however, remains to be seen.

Sow Bears Two Litters Of Pigs in Three Weeks

ROCHESTER, IND.—Fulton county had its best pig story of the year recently. Everett Best, manager of the Otto McMahans farms near here, reported that on April 13, a registered Hampshire sow gave birth to six red pigs and three weeks later, on May 4, the same sow gave birth to nine Hampshire pigs. Best said he is bottle-feeding the six red pigs while the sow is caring for the others.

Colored Ack-Ack Fire Shows Up in N. Guinea

SOMEWHERE IN NORTH GUINEA.—A new type of anti-aircraft fire—brilliantly colored and of blinding intensity—was encountered by Flying Fortress pilots over Rabaul in the darkness of a pre-dawn raid recently. The use of this type of anti-aircraft shell has been reported elsewhere in Europe, but this was its first reported appearance in the southwest Pacific theater.

Washington Busy, Tense

The evacuees will recall that General Eisenhower's brother, Milton Eisenhower, preceded Dillon Myer as War Relocation Authority director. While the general was in command of American forces in the early phases of the African campaign, he was visited by his brother. At the War Department's Pentagon building in Washington, D. C., Secretary of War Henry L. Stimson was not present; but Assistant Secretary of War John H. McClary was in his office. He, it will be recalled, supervised the initial phases of the evacuation from the west coast.

He Needs Extension of Leave to Spend Money

CAMP CROWDER, MO.—Private Thomas Williams has a new reason for wanting an extension of the furlough he has been promised. In view of the furlough prospect he sent eight telegrams to his sisters and brothers, hoping to receive some extra spending money from at least one of them. So far, all of a sudden telegrams started pouring in, and he received money orders from all of them. The only way he can spend the money for proper furlough purposes is to get the extension.

Assault Forces Strikes France

First units of Allied assault troops began landing on the French coast, across the English Channel and the British Isles at 1:25 a.m. Rocky Mountain War Time (6 a.m. London time) this morning. This marked the D-Day. As the massed American, British and Canadian troops crossed the channel, and British-U. S. air forces pummeled the landing beaches, the nervously awaiting Nazi forces made their expected and furious counterattacks, according to reports issued from the Supreme Headquarters of the Allied Expeditionary Force this morning. As of dawn today, Tuesday, particulars regarding the progress of the long-awaited invasion remained to be disclosed.

Victory Gardens to Float on Lake Laté

SPRIT LAKE, IDAHO—Now it's floating Victory gardens. Arthur Velguth, lacking sufficient soil at home, will convert his three landing docks at Spirit Lake into gardens. He plans to cover the docks with good black soil and plant his crops. The gardens—he hopes—will absorb water from the lake, thus eliminating sprinkling.

Declares Japs Trying To Divert Yellow River

KUANGSING, CHINA.—The Japanese, under their arm and seemingly intent on diverting the Yellow river, the local army newspaper San Tang Pao has reported. The paper said the move was part of Japanese preparations for a last ditch fight in north China. The Japanese were said to be planning to cut a channel in the Yellow flow into the sea.

Control Over Workers Coming

All male workers 17 and older, according to Washington, D. C. dispatches, will be placed under semi-compulsory control from July 1 by the War Manpower Control Act.

Eisenhower

Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower, commander of the Allied forces, will plan the invasion strategy, issued the order of the day in London today to his troops. His opening remarks were: "You are about to embark on a great crusade. We will accept nothing less than full victory. Good luck and let us all beseech the blessings of Almighty God upon this great and noble undertaking."
