U. S. RECIPROCAL EXCHANGE URGED

Washington—Arrangements have been made for a Japanese ship to enter a Soviet port near Vladivostok to take on 1,500 tons of accumulated relief supplies for American and other Allied prisoners of war and civilians held by Japan, the state department announced Friday. The United States government has agreed to pay all costs connected with the transportation of these supplies to Japan and has told the Japanese government it would be willing to reciprocate in distributing relief supplies sent by Japan for Japanese nationals in United States custody.
