Express Shipment Permission Is Granted

Commercial equipment belonging to evacuees and weighing not more than 500 pounds may be shipped by express rather than freight.

The occasional need for faster delivery of tools, equipment, or fixtures of an evacuee's trade or business can be possible under freight shipments, and the particular nature of some equipment, has necessitated a change in regulations governing free Government shipment of evacuee commercial property.
