TWO MORE PERMITTED TO RETURN TO COAST; 3 UNDER EXCLUSION

Los Angeles—Predicting an early settlement of evacuee problem, by virtue of the necessity for returning to the "constitutional" way of "handling" evacuees, the Open Forum of the Civil Liberties Union disclosed the Western Defense Command's decision to place three more petitioners for return to the West Coast on individual exclusion orders, allowing two plaintiffs to return to the coast.

Los Angeles—The Los Angeles Research Jury recently issued a questionnaire asking: "In your opinion, should there be a constitutional amendment after the war for the deportation of all Japanese from this country, and for forbidding their immigration?"
