Deputy Marshal Fined \$100 in Assault Case

Fort Lupton, Colo.—George G. Smith, Jr., U. S. deputy marshal from Cheyenne, Wyo., pleaded guilty to charges of assault and battery Thursday night and was fined \$100 and court costs.

He appeared before Justice of the Peace Charles Lundien. The hearing was first set Thursday morning, postponed to next Monday, then held in a special session Thursday night.

The charges involved the striking of a 19-year-old youth of Japanese descent on a Fort Lupton street. The youth testified he received a fractured nose after Smith, driving thru town, stopped and walked over to him.

He said Smith apparently thought "name" shouted by Caucasians who entered the auditorium were given complimentary tickets at the door, but refused requests from Japanese-Americans.

"I think this is a fine example of Fascism in Denver," Masaka said last night. "When people are so fearful of facing frank discussion that they invent a device to allow only sympathetic persons, then they are afraid to face the truth."

BATTLE STORY OF INFANTRYMEN

Washington — Battle exploits of American soldiers of Japanese ancestry are related in a pamphlet issued today by the Interior Department's War Relocation Authority.

"Men whose parents came from Japan are showing that devotion to America and gallantry in action are not determined by the color of the skin," says the pamphlet, entitled "Nisei in Uniform."

The pamphlet describes the record of the 100th Infantry Battalion, whose 1300 members in Italy received 1000 Purple Hearts and a Presidential Citation, and the Combat Team, 90 per cent of whose men have won combat infantrymen's badges.

FORCE TO KEEP OUT OCHIKUBO

Los Angeles — U. S. Atty. Charles H. Carr says army authorities will, if necessary, use physical and military force to prevent Dr. George Ochikubo from returning to military areas from which he has been excluded, including California.

Ochikubo, American-born Japanese dentist formerly of Oakland, Calif., is in a relocation camp at Topaz, Utah. He has filed a federal court petition to restrain the army from preventing his return to California.

Carr filed an answer in behalf of Maj. Gen. Charles H. Bone, commanding general of the western defense command, which said:

EIGHT AMACE MEN RECEIVE SENTENCES FROM FEDERAL JUDGE

Sixteen Japanese men of Amache, Colo., who previously had pleaded not guilty to violations of the selective service law, changed their pleas to nolo contendere Tuesday afternoon and were sentenced by U. S. District Judge Symes.

Hideo Inaba received a one-year term. Sentences of eight months were received by Joe Kashiwagi, Menoru Joe Yoshida and Yoshimitsu Ishikawa. Fred T. Asai, Harry S. Ioka and Joe H. Morikane were sentenced to nine months each. Dix T. Asai received a ten-month term.

CALIFORNIANS THINK EVACUEES RETURNING FROM NOVEMBER 15

Welfare Director Declares He Refused To Make State Survey of Acceptability

Sacramento — State officials were told today there is "good reason" to believe that both American and alien-born Japanese "will begin filtering back into California communities beginning November 15 and thereafter."

The report came from Charles M. Wollenberg, director of the State Department of Social Welfare, who told a meeting of Governor Earl Warren's council that his department had "flatly refused" to make a survey suggested by the War Relocation Authority.

Wollenberg said he had been approached a few days ago by agents of the WRA, and was asked by them if his department would undertake to learn if former Japanese residents of various cities and counties would be accepted in their localities.

"We absolutely refused," declared Wollenberg, "on the ground that it was the Federal Government that took them away, and it is their job to get them back."

Wollenberg said he understood there were plans to start returning Japanese to California communities from various relocation centers some time ago, but that was called off, and it is not clear there will be anything new now.
