Salt Lake City—Calling on President Roosevelt to issue invitations for a White House conference on minorities, the National JAEL conference held Dec. 1-3 here made a number of decisions.

In its petition to the President the League pointed out that the domestic problems of minorities is of growing national concern, especially typified in the wartime treatment of persons of Japanese descent.

STIMSON SCORES ACT OF HOOD RIVER LEGION

Hood River, Ore.—A protest flared across the nation tonight against the removal of the names of 16 Japanese American soldiers from the Hood River American Legion Post roll of honor.

Secretary Stimson said such action was wholly inconsistent with the American ideal of democracy, and a breach from a New York City Legion Post, the Hood River Post stood by its action.

The Hood River Post explained previously that strong opposition in the area to the return of Japanese American soldiers had inspired the removal of the names.

Grave Error Of Policy," Says Group

Sacramento—H. J. McClatchy, executive secretary of the California Immigration Committee, today condemned the wartime return of Japanese to the Pacific Coast as "a grave error of policy," but declared that the rights of those who are allowed to come back to their former homes must be protected.

Military authorities who ordered the relocation of the Japanese after Pearl Harbor have allowed the Japanese to return as a result of "a continuing pressure from the War Relocation Authority and other interests selfishly seeking some gain for themselves," McClatchy told the executive committee of the California Department of the American Legion.

"Such a return," McClatchy said, "is bound to create a spirit of unrest and must necessarily increase the protective efforts of those agencies charged with the defense measures. But our committee is unanimous in holding that if the military authorities revoke previous orders as to the Japanese then those who are American citizens are legally entitled to move freely any place in the United States, not excepting the Pacific Coast."

ARMY WILL PERMIT APPROVED EVACUEES TO RETURN TO THE PACIFIC COAST

Japanese evacuees in Colorado and other states will be allowed to return to their old homes on the West Coast after January 2 if their loyalty is proven, the army announced yesterday in San Francisco.

The mass exclusion order, which has been in effect for two years, will be lifted at midnight January 2 because an enemy invasion of the West Coast no longer is a "substantial possibility," the Western Defense Command announced.

Bill of Rights in 47 States?

Los Angeles—Vigorously condemning agitation to have evacuated Japanese from returning to California as a result of the Bill of Rights and something that should not be permitted, Assistant WRA Director R. B. Crozier declared at the Junior Chamber of Commerce meeting.

"It is difficult for me," he said, "to understand how the Bill of Rights can function in 47 states and not in California." He said that the WRA has made arrangements for them, but it would return to the West Coast. No immediate influx of Japanese to the West Coast is expected, Maj. Gen. Henry C. Pratt, commanding general of the Western Defense Command, said yesterday. A few Japanese at a time will be returned after the WRA has made arrangements for them, he added.

The War Department stressed that Japanese have been under thorough investigation since Pearl Harbor, and that disloyal ones had been weeded out. It said conduct of Japanese units as a whole has been excellent and that it is possible to make sound judgments as to their loyalty."
