60,000 MAY RETURN HOME, WRA BELIEVES

San Francisco—Approximately 60,000 persons of Japanese ancestry are expected to return to their former homes on the West Coast after the Army's revocation of its exclusion orders, effective January 31, but the return will be gradual and will probably extend over a period of 18 months, it was indicated at the WRA office here last week.

"Magnificent Record of Service" Lauded

"Americanism is not a matter of race or ancestry." This was the message of Secretary of Interior Harold I. Ickes to nisei soldiers who, he said, have "fashioned a magnificent record of service." "All good Americans are proud of you," he added.

On The Other Hand—

THE PROPOSITION Any way you look at the proposition, this is an auspicious year that the evacuees are picking up for resettlement.

After hibernating for two years in the camps, the issei and nisei housewives are going to resume their kitchen commands and get in their licks at thumbing through ration books. And this in a year when the OPA tells us, purchasable goods—especially food—probably will be more restricted than ever before.

One can imagine that the issei housewives might be in a slightly better position with respect to food purchases, so long as they stick to such presently non-rationed items as rice, fish, miso, and the remaining obtainable native staples. The strictly butter-meat menus preferred by many nisei housewives, will cause them to toe the line.

This is an auspicious year for evacuees to resume normal lives, we say, not because of these limitations, but for while they mean to tell all Americans in terms of sacrifices we are called upon to make to insure the continuation of the kind of good living we would like to enjoy in our land.

Chaplain Criticizes "Moribund Twig"

Hood River, Ore.—Some background information was being dug up yesterday here following the nationwide furor over the local Legion post's act of striking out names of 10 nisei soldiers from the community honor roll.

It was reported that Rev. J. P. Clancy, chaplain of Portland Post No. 1, American Legion, in a letter to the Hood River Oregonian, in which he told of the death of one of his parishioners, a nisei, from a high explosive shell in Italy, referred to the Hood River Post as a "moribund twig of the most influential organization in the United States—the American Legion."

According to figures quoted hereabouts, this area had the greatest proportion of Japanese to total population of any place in the U.S.A. There were 402 Japanese in the most fertile portions of Hood River county in 1944, in an area the total population of which was 4,500. Of the 402, 306 were nisei.

A warning to former Japanese residents not returned was published in quarter page advertisements in Hood River newspaper on December 24th.

At the same time, it was disclosed that he had addressed a "Jap Return Protest, Mass Meeting," in Brawley, California, on Pearl Harbor Day, December 7th.

When they were relocated, they said, they were forced to get rid of their belongings for almost nothing. Older Japanese men and women who spent a lifetime establishing small businesses which they had to get out of as best they could, feel there "just isn't any starting over" for them.

Los Angeles—Only evacuees with a job and a place to live or an approved plan for their future will be assisted by the WRA, in returning to the coast. Paul G. Robertson, WRA area supervisor here, declared last week. Assistance given Japanese applying for aid in returning to their former homes will consist generally of transportation, advice on reclaiming their property, and medical aid, he said.

70 Head For Santa Fe Internment Camp

San Francisco—Seventy male residents of the Tule Lake Segregation Center, some of them American-born Japanese who voluntarily renounced their United States citizenship under a new law, left the northern California center today for Santa Fe to enter the Department of Justice camp for enemy aliens. They were accompanied by forty guards provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service.

20 NISEIS GET BRONZE STARS

With the Sixth Army Group in France—Bronze stars were awarded today by Lt. Gen. Jacob L. Devers to 20 Japanese American soldiers, including one from Hood River, Ore., where the names of nisei service men recently were removed from a war honor roll by the American Legion.
