On The Other Hand

ALL ABOVE BOARD
Everything connected with the evacuation, segregation, internment and resettlement have been above-board operations.

So it is without trepidations that we note the report of House Immigration Committee's wish to call on Interior Secretary Ickes and Attorney General Biddle's departments to ask how they handled segregation, and how they handled the "several thousand" evacuees who told WRA that they would not promise to support the U. S. A."

All of this came about with the assembling of the new Congressional session, Chairman Dickstein (D.), New York, labels this matter, "Investigation." The label doesn't matter. What does matter is that the evacuees would be the first to welcome this form of opportunity to state their case for historical documentation.

NAYES STAND OUT

Out of 15,870 replies received last week in San Francisco by news analyst, Sam Hayes, it was reported that 97 per cent are opposed to the return of evacuees to the coast. Hayes had asked them what they thought of the "Return of the Japanese."

4-F MEN STREAM INTO WAR WORK

Washington—Draft officials made it doubly plain on Capitol Hill yesterday they want 4-Fs drafted for either a uniform or a war job and threw out a hint also that the older men of the nation are not beyond call for duty.

At the same time, his superior, Maj. Gen. Lewis B. Hershey, draft director, wrote in an official publication that the war "can no longer be regarded as a young man's war."

There was immediate speculation whether Hershey is forecasting a change in the draft status of the older registrants now deferred.
