

Nisei Uncertain of Future in Shelton, Neb. District

OMAHA. — The status of 11 Nisei in the Shelton-Gibbon area will be in doubt unless speedy new efforts to dissolve the Nisei are made over their employment.

WRA officer W. K. Holland and Mrs. H. R. Lippincott, wife of the owner of the 800-acre farm on which the Nisei are employed, Monday presented facts substantiating the protest to U. S. district attorney Joseph Volava here. Volava declined to say whether legal steps could be taken to keep the Nisei employed on the farm.

"I haven't made up my mind what I will do," Volava said.

Holland asserted that "with the present shortage of farm help in Nebraska it seems strange that a movement is afoot to force these farm hands to leave the community where there is such a desperate need for production for the armed forces as well as for our cities and for civilian consumption."

"We all believe in the four freedoms," the WRA official said, "but it appears that the 'freedom of opportunity' is certainly being taken away from this small group of citizens whose presence in the area is occasioned by the need to make a livelihood for themselves and their families and work in farming—the occupation for which they are best qualified."

Mrs. Lippincott said the Nisei "want to stay."

"They are Americans whether we like it or not and are entitled to the courtesies every other American citizen is entitled to," she said.

At Kearney, Mr. Lippincott said he planned to call Senator Wherry regarding the situation.

Lippincott, who arrived in Shelton Tuesday, said in an interview that Negroes, brought to the Shelton area to help in the crop, had put a few years ago on the Nisei.

"I am sure it is permitted to do this," he said, "and the people here are not handing it to you and your family."

Lippincott made it clear that he has no direct interest in what is raised on his 800 acres this year. He said he leased the land to John Niedfeldt and Harold Camp of the Platte Valley Constellation Co. of Grand Island.

"I've already received the rental payment," he said. "It's their battle, not mine. But I'm disturbed about what is happening. I'm disturbed when a man

can't employ American citizens to work on his land.

"It is my understanding that one of the things we are fighting against is the persecution of racial minorities. I notice by the papers that the Japanese Americans are good enough to be soldiers, and do some of the toughest fighting in Italy, but it seems they are not good enough to raise foodstuffs when millions of people in the world are on a starvation diet."

He estimated the Platte Valley Construction Co. has an investment of \$100,000 in the farm.

'Realistic' Guide Fixed for Japanese Farm Benefits

FRESNO. — A policy termed "realistic" by Chairman Frank Long was invoked this week by the Fresno County Agricultural Adjustment Agency Committee concerning applications from returning Japanese for benefit farm and soil conservation payments.

Long announced the county committee will not make any payments until the Japanese furnish proof by affidavit they have repudiated dual citizenship and are not citizens of any other country.

In addition, Long said the Japanese will be required to furnish statements from District Attorney James M. Thuesen that titles to their farms are not nor never have been in question regarding alien property laws.

Opposed by WRA

He said WRA officials, whom he would not identify, expressed vigorous opposition to the measure. However, the WRA's district relocation officer, Paul J. Fisher, would not comment on the matter.

"The policy was drawn on an over-all basis shortly after Pearl Harbor," said Long. "But we had no reason to invoke it until recently when 15 or 20 applications were received from Japanese."

Four More Relocation Offices Due in Southern Cal.

LOS ANGELES. — The WRA will open four additional offices in Southern California to aid in the resettlement of some 12,000 Japanese Americans expected to return from relocation centers before Jan. 1, Dillon S. Myer, national WRA chief, announced this week.

The new bureaus will be in Santa Barbara, Santa Ana, El Centro and San Diego.

Myer linked his disclosure with the statement that all Southern California branches of WRA hereafter will function on an autonomous basis, responsible only to Washington. The Seattle office also will operate in a similar manner.

He said there still are 55,000 Japanese Americans in relocation centers eligible for return to Japan in any part of the United States. About 20,000 are school children.

Approximately 500 Japanese have returned to the nine Southern California counties comprising this WRA area, Myer said. In California 1199 have been resettled.

Evacuee Property Service to Become Relocation Division At All Levels

WASHINGTON. — Evacuee property services formerly directed jointly by the Administrative Management Division in Washington and the San Francisco field office will become the responsibility of the Relocation Division at all levels, effective April 10, WRA Director Dillon S. Myer announced.

Under a general realignment of basic functions outlined in Administrative Notice 239, West Coast area relocation offices in Arizona, California, Oregon, and Washington will report directly to the Relocation Division in Washington, and will function exactly as other area offices.

The Assistant Director in San Francisco reporting directly to the Director, in a staff relationship will coordinate the problems of WRA over the entire West Coast. In addition, with state officials in California and Federal officials, including the military, coordinate public relations throughout the area and in general expedite established policies and procedures with all WRA personnel.

Professor Says Soldiers Rap Japanese Boycott

SACRAMENTO. — Dr. Knauth Reyeron, director of the University of California College of Agriculture at Davis, Yolo County, told a meeting of the Council for Civic Unity "American troops fighting in the South Pacific do not like the attitude of some Americans in California who favor a boycott against the return of the Japanese Americans to the West Coast."

Reyeron recently returned from the South Pacific as a representative of the board of economic welfare, where he taught American troops to raise crops to supplement their diets. He declared:

"I met many American soldiers who are fighting the Japanese and they all asked 'what the hell are we fighting for?' We went to school with many of the Japanese Americans and they are as good as Americans as we are."

"Many of the Japanese Americans in the South Pacific act as interpreters—a very hazardous occupation because of the possibility they might be mistaken for enemy soldiers.

"It will take all the tolerance in the world to work out the problem. It cannot be solved by passion, bitterness or intolerance. America is great because of the contributions of all racial groups."

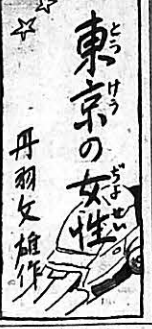
