\$1,000 Reward to Bar Attacks On Nisei in Calif. Revealed

SACRAMENTO. — A standing reward of \$1,000 will be posted by the American Civil Liberties Union for the arrest and conviction of any person attacking a Japanese American in California.

This was disclosed by Attorney General Robert W. Kenny at a session of the one day conference of the California Councils of Civic Unity.

Kenny said the Civil Liberties Union had offered the reward as a means of curbing attacks against Japanese Americans who have been returned to the West Coast. California law does not permit the payment of such rewards by the State, Kenny declared.

Identity Is Secret

The reward is to be paid for each case resulting in a felony conviction. The attorney general stated the identity of the person receiving the reward will not be revealed.

At the same time, Kenny told appropriate representatives of various relations groups from all parts of the state that the frequency of disturbances involving attacks on Japanese Americans in the state has subsided in recent weeks, and it is hoped the posting of the reward will discourage them entirely.

Court Bans Commercial Leases By Alien Japanese

STOCKTON. — In an unprecedented ruling, Superior Judge Marion G. Woodward last week enjoined alien Japanese to do not have the right to lease and occupy commercial property in California.

The ruling was made in a suit brought by Emil Palermo, Stockton, against Stockton Theatres, Inc., an alien Japanese-controlled corporation of the American Council of Races.

The firm, known as Oriental American Practices, was to be conducted by Lee Angeles.

Mrs. Harry Kinnan of San Francisco was the program chairman. The meeting was planned under the sponsorship of the Sacramento and San Joaquin chapters of the American Council on Race Relations and the Pacific Coast Committee on American Principles and Fair Play.

At the time the lease was executed it was permissible under a treaty then existing between Japan and the United States to freely lease land in 1940 and since that time the lease was unlawful under the laws of California, Judge Woodward held.
