In those early weeks of confusion and war-fright, Japanese Americans were treated as traitors. In their silence of the terror of the Fascist state, Out of the maelstrom came a call for volunteer Japanese Americans to form a special combat regiment. Many young Japanese volunteers had the primary purpose to prove their loyalty to the United States Government.

The record of the Nisei was brilliant. In Italy they had spearheaded the American drive up the Ligurian coast; participated in the only amphibious assault on the Mediterranean theatre; had killed more Germans than any other 8th Army regiment.

At home, on the West Coast, American justice reached a millennium in the sovereign state of California. Not only did the later American justice had such an example of pure racial hatred been evident.

At a trial in Auburn, California, three U. S. Army privates were tried for the willful destruction of the homes of Japanese Americans. The trial was based on the conclusive argument, "There's some Japs here I don't like." The defendants admitted their crime proudly. They did not omit the fact that they had returned again the following evening and attempted to repeat the outrage.

All charges brought forward by the prosecution were admitted by the defense. Defense attorney Floyd Bower's argument was based upon the Batson Death March, and that the defendants were "loyal white Americans" protecting yellow about them. His final punch was, "It is a white man's country." It hit hard.

The jury allowed itself two hours to formulate the verdict of not guilty. The same three white Americans were released and the same three Japanese had saved their lives.

In San Francisco, men from many lands were attempting to lay the foundations to the house of world peace and tolerance. Other Americans were sabotaging their efforts a few miles away.

Some Americans had forgotten their obligation because called to defend the civil rights of its inhabitants, it could not be sensitive towards the grave problems facing it.

Americans need to be reminded of the words of Associate Justice Murphy, when he said,

"If in the atmosphere of war we allow civil liberties to slip away from us, it will not be long before our recent gains in social and economic progress also vanish."

Intolerance has no place in America. Those who adhere to it are making a wide detour from the traditions of a country which has always stood for "one people" into the American Constitution. America became great, only because it remained spiritually one people.

Our country's future lies in the souls of these peoples of many creeds and races. Should American people make these diverse peoples akin to them, America's future cannot be a happy one. It was peoples of diverse origin that hewed thru the wilderness of America to make it a nation.

At Auburn last month, the charge of intolerance was beginning to gnaw at the prows of American justice. Should such a policy continue, it could only result in tyranny.

The Hayano family, prior to evacuation, were residents of Mt. Vernon, Washington. While at Heart Mountain, Mr. Hayano supplied tofu to Center residents for a period of seven months.

ACLU Renews Appeal To Navy To Lift Nisei Ban

Baldwin Contends Policy Was Set by Field Officers

NEW YORK.—The American Civil Liberties Union is appealing again to Navy Secretary Forrestal in his fight to breach the official stranglehold of discrimination against Japanese Americans at the Japanese American Relocation Center at Boulder, Colo., side car tire testimony.

3 Japanese American women were barred from the WAVES because it would have been unfair to the Nisei men to permit the women in Navy service.

Roger Baldwin, ACLU director, is urging Forrestal to have the discriminatory regulation rescinded and lift the ban against the Nisei, since the Navy Dept.'s position has been that the field officers set the policy.

Forrestal, like his predecessor, the late Frank E. Knox, has maintained that "for practical reasons it is impossible to put American of Japanese ancestry on ships." The stock arguments are:

1. The Nisei might be impersonated by Americans.

2. Assimilation of Japanese Americans in close ship quarters would be difficult.

But in the Army, the Nisei

have proved completely they can get along well with others.

3. Japanese American women were barred from the WAVES because it would have been unfair to the Nisei men to permit the women in Navy service.

So the discrimination was reduced to allowing an "injustice."

Only Department

"The Navy is the only department of Government which today excludes Americans of Japanese ancestry from any position whatever," Baldwin said.

What discrimination there is in other departments is only to keep the Navy admiral's wife.

We've been trying to break down this barrier for a long time.

"Navy decisions are made, not Washington, by the civilian personnel, but by the commanders in the field."

Baldwin pointed out that "the Navy excludes Japanese Americans in California, Washington and Oregon from any work in defense plants under Navy contract. This applies even to discharged Nisei Army veterans, not matter what company they work for."

He said that the Navy admiral's wife held a job in Hawaii, while many Japanese Americans can work in a war plant closer to Japan, they are considered dangerous to the war effort.

Prerequisite

"The only decision one can make is that the Navy has yielded to the pressure of prejudice and anti-Japanese American economic interests on the Pacific Coast."

The ACLU director also said that on Okinawa and Iwo Jima a very considerable number of Japanese Americans, discharged from the Army, fought in the Marines so conspicuously well that the Marines asked for more. There was not a single case of malloyalty or desertion.
