The new members are: Harry Dobashi, 26, Thomas Okagaki, 19, Mario Sera, 47, and Morotomi Kinaga, 48. This makes a total of 100 evacuees who have been admitted to membership in the union.

Fresno. — Miss Masae Yasuhira, a registered nurse, has returned here and is employed in the surgical ward of St. Agnes Hospital. She is the first Nisei nurse to be employed in Fresno county since evacuation.

Wakonville. — Kenneth Sato, with his wife and father-in-law, Mr. Manaka, are recent returns from Denver. Mr. Manaka expects to operate the hotel soon to be opened in Monterey.

San Jose. — Two small grass fires occurred recently on the premises of Rhoitsu Shibusawa, at his ranch home near Monterey View. Investigation by a WRA representative confirmed the report of a constable that the fires were doubtless of accidental origin. Each occurred along a fence and were probably the result of cigarettes tossed, from passing cars. No damage was reported.

Visalia. — Sgt. Tom Yokoyama, who is serving in an Army hospital in Chicago, has been visiting his home near Oroquieta, where he has been reported to be doing well. ### San Luis Obispo Telegram-Tribune: Japs—And U. S. Soldiers

For the purpose of expressing our own editorial stand, we herewith publish, in full, a letter to the editor which came to us from Arroyo Grande with "One of Your Subscribers" as the only signature.

"To the Editor or to whom it should concern: I have just received your issue of the 24th. In Wednesday night's copy of the Telegram-Tribune, the picture of a Jap boy and his father appeared on the front page, stating that they had met in Okinawa after eight years.

"As one of your subscribers, I putribly believe that you should exclude such pictures and put in pictures of our boys who deserve the right to have their pictures in the paper and which do more far more for their country than such barbarous cowardly which one can't even call them human. The boys who deserve the right to have their pictures in the paper is our good American Yank which have fought and died for our country.

"The saying has always been the only good Jap is a dead one, and it still holds true in every case."

The picture in question was titled "Hisa's Pop" and showed T/4 Seizuro Higachi, 10th Army man and interpreter for the 24th Division G-2, greeting his father on Okinawa for the first time in eight years. Higachi was born in Los Angeles, moved to Okinawa with his family as a youngster, and later returned to the states to live.

It is our feeling that any soldier who went through the Okinawa campaign, be his name Smith, Jones, O'Brien, Greenbaum or Higachi, is more than worthy of having his picture on the front page of any newspaper in the land.

Remember, Subscriber, that to most of us, T/4 Higachi is a soldier of the American Army, a soldier who, by going through that ferocious campaign, has done more for his adopted country than you or I or any of us who are now on the battle line in that war can hope to do.

We have yet to hear any serviceman look down upon a Japanese American combat soldier or dismiss him, with the "A Jap's a Jap" label.

Does this Subscriber dare to

call this man, an Okinawa veteran, a coward? Has the Subscriber taken the time to consider the facts of the case? We think not.

T/4 Higachi was good enough for the United States Army—good enough for combat service in one of the most perilous spots of the Pacific war. That makes him good enough for our front page.

TURLOCK, Calif. — State Senator Hugh P. Hennessy charged the WRA with aiding Japanese who are trying to circumvent the alien land laws. "Before the war," the Japanese Government was known to provide money through its agents in the United States for purchase of California land," Donnelly said, "and for the hiring of local advice in retaining the land. Now, the WRA has taken over the latter function and is furnishing advice for its charge."

### 150 Evacuees Leave Granada

A trainload of about 150 Japanese evacuees from the Granada camp left by Santa Fe railroad train Wednesday to return to their homes on the West Coast. The destination of the train was Oakland, Calif.

The trip, for the most part, was made on the underrun day coaches, although an air-conditioned Pullman coach was provided for the old and the infirm. The train left the railroad station at 10:30 a. m. and arrived in Oakland Thursday.

The transfer of additional evacuees to their West Coast homes will be effected later this week.

A similar transfer is under way from Rohwer, Ark., with about 400 Japanese to be moved from that relocation center to their homes in California, Colorado and Utah. The group of about 125 families is the first mass movement to the West in preparation for discontinuance of the colony Dec. 5, Ray Johnson, director at Rohwer, said.

A few of the Japanese who plan resettlement in the mountain states will leave the train at Pueblo for Denver, Colo., and at Ogden and Salt Lake City, Utah.

The others will travel on to Los Angeles and San Francisco. Donnelly's charge on to the authority is "throwing stones in the legal path of the attorney general's office, to prevent prosecution of land law violations is ridiculous."

District Director Cecil Morgan said he challenged anyone to find any illegal subversive in any WRA pamphlet. WRA does provide legal advice for Japanese in relocation centers and issue pamphlets, he said, but only to bring the evacuees up to date on new government regulations.

"Remember, these people were in relocation centers for three years," he said. "They know very little about rationing, the Office of Price Administration, and other federal and state legislation and agencies."

Donnelly, chairman of the senate committee investigating alien and enemy activities, said WRA pamphlets he received from the San Francisco regional office advised Japanese, "both alien and citizen," on the "limitations" of

California with groups getting off at Lodi, Sacramento, Stockton, Fresno and Los Angeles.

Many of the disembarking evacuees will disperse from the train to their homes in smaller towns and nearby rural areas. From Lodi onward cars will be dropped from the train with only two coaches, the sleeper and one baggage car going on to the last stop at Los Angeles.

Under WRA regulations, returning Japanese have submitted plans showing they have adequate housing. Many will return to their own farms. Others will be housed as ranch workers.

Approximately 6000 Japanese have already returned to California, about 500 to San Francisco, WRA said.

### Race Violence—U. S. Acts

Two Federal Charges In Auburn Dynamite Case

SAN FRANCISCO. — Federal charges will be brought against two civilian brothers for the dynamiting of a Nisei's property in Auburn, United States Attorney Frank J. Hennessy announced this week.

One of the brothers, James E. Watson, 38, an Auburn bartender, was acquitted in a State court last April of the same charges. His brother, Charles Watson, 35, a rancher, originally was accused of the crime by local officials, but charges against him were dropped.

Two AWOL soldiers, also brothers, were acquitted but now reportedly facing an Army court martial, were Alvin J. Johnson, 18, and Elmer Johnson, 20.

Hennessy said the Government will not seek indictments against the soldier brothers. "I have instructed the United States attorney in Sacramento to ask the Federal Grand Jury there for indictments against the two civilian brothers on two counts," Hennessy announced.
