

CONGRESSMAN DECLARES BACK DOOR IS OPEN TO UNDESIRABLE ALIENS

LOS ANGELES. — Representative Samuel Dickstein, Democrat of New York, says some congressmen "day and night to keep the front door closed against undesirable aliens, yet they leave the back door wide open for them to pour in."

Chairman Dickstein asserted at a subcommittee hearing on immigration matters that alien quota laws are "rock-solid and ridiculous."

His comments followed testimony by District Immigration Director Albert Del Guercio that almost 100,000 alien Mexicans are in Southern California. Del Guercio termed them mostly "border jumpers."

"Unalterable" opposition to statehood for Hawaii was expressed by Edward L. Meyer, past grand president of the Native Sons of the Golden West. Declaring the 1940 census shows

'Not Guilty' Pleas Made in Doi Case

SACRAMENTO. — Pleas of not guilty were entered in Federal Court here last Thursday by James Edward Watson, 39, and his brother, Claude, 35, charged with being part of a conspiracy to dynamite and destroy in connection with the attempted dynamiting of property owned by Sumio Doi in Placer County. Federal Judge Martin I. Welsh set October 2 as the date for their trial.

Alien Loses Land Title in Court

SALINAS. — In a decision against Yoizo Ikeda, Japanese alien, Superior Judge H. G. Jorgensen has ruled that title to approximately 72 acres of farming land here goes to the state under the Alien Land law.

District Attorney Anthony Brazil charged Mr. and Mrs. Ikeda bought the land in 1924, replacing it in the name of a friend, Toshi Hanasome, until their daughter, Atsuko, became of age.

The court held that the statute of limitations could not be applied in the case because "to allow an ineligible alien to remain in possession of agricultural land after 10 years would be just as much against public policy as to allow them to remain the first

Coast Ban Lifted On U. S. Japanese

WASHINGTON. — The Army Tuesday night removed all bars against local Japanese Americans returning to the Pacific Coast.

It promised them the same treatment and privileges "accorded other law-abiding American citizens and residents."

Mass exclusion was ended in December, 1944, and the restrictions were placed on an individual basis.

The action, effective at midnight, Pacific war time (1 a.m. MWT), formally terminated the mass exclusion program under which persons Japanese ancestry had been banned from the coastal areas of California, Oregon and Washington since early in the war.

At the same time, the WRA announced that its eight relocation centers will be closed gradually beginning next month, with the last scheduled to shut down early in the war.

The action, effective at midnight, Pacific war time (1 a.m. MWT), formally terminated the mass exclusion program under which persons Japanese ancestry had been banned from the coastal areas of California, Oregon and Washington since early in the war.

Japanese Physician Helped Toward A-Bomb

BOULDER, Colo. — Ironically, a Boulder native scientist helped pave the way for the development of the atomic bomb. Dr. James W. Broxton, University of Colorado physicist, said here.

Dr. Broxton, who took part in the research work on the weapon, said that in 1935 M. Yukawa, a Japanese physicist, was the first to point out the existence of the mesotron, which proved to be a "significant contribution."

Far from regarding Japanese scientists as "copy cats," Dr. Broxton said other nations "may well consider the possibility that the Japanese may develop an atomic bomb of their own."

Chicago Has City FEPC

CHICAGO. — Chicago now has an "FEPC" for the city, even if the state legislature did reject a fair employment practices act for the state last spring.

The City Council recently approved an ordinance which prohibits racial discrimination in City employment and on any jobs performed for the City by private contractors and subcontractors. The ordinance was introduced by two Negro aldermen and was passed by a vote of 39 to 1.

A broader clause in the ordinance calls for a \$200 fine against any person found guilty of practicing racial discrimination in such matters of employment as hiring and firing. The ordinance also states that unions shall not discriminate on the basis of color.

Mr. Thomas Wright, Executive Director of the Mayor's Committee on Race Relations, told the WRA that although the legality of certain measures in the ordinance may have to be tested in the courts, the ordinance represents a tremendous step forward in trying to make democracy work. It is Mr. Wright's hope that management and labor will cooperate in making the law 100 per cent effective.

Japanese Sentenced to Prison for Two Years

SACRAMENTO. — A sentence of two years in a federal penitentiary was imposed by Federal Judge Martin I. Welsh on Ken Sugiyama, former Tule Lake Relocation Center Japanese, who pleaded guilty to a charge of claiming falsely citizenship in the United States.

Sugiyama was arrested in New York City following his release from the relocation center. He was indicted last month by the federal grand jury here.

LAND DEALS IN PLACER PROBED

AUBURN (Placer Co.). — District Attorney C. E. Tindall of Placer County announced investigations have been resumed by his office to ascertain if the California alien land law has been violated in Placer County.

The investigations began April 1 with J. Mulvey of the attorney general's staff in charge. They were discontinued after one action against Senzaro Kondo and Eiji Kondo had been filed April 14th. Mulvey was withdrawn from the county soon afterward by Attorney General Robert Kenny. Tindall stated there had been some delay while a qualified investigator could be obtained.

In the clerk's office it was ascertained Kondo has not filed an answer to the exchequer proceedings started in April by Tindall and the attorney general.

A report compiled by the Placer County Defense Council in 1942 indicated more than 180 parcels of land in Placer County were owned by persons of Japanese ancestry.

Data assembled by the defense council are being checked.
