COAST HOUSING SITUATION AIDED BY WRA AND FPHA

WASHINGTON. — Two developments expected to aid the housing situation for evacuees returning to the West Coast have resulted from cooperative agreements between the War Relocation Authority and the Federal Public Housing Authority. They are:

1. Evacuees have been defined by the Federal Public Housing Authority as persons displaced by the war effort and consequently will be eligible for vacancies in family housing facilities operated by the FPFA as they become available. Families of veterans and others connected with liquidation of the war program will continue to have first priority.

2. Families will be eligible for occupancy of such trailer or dormitory projects as the FPFA may designate in localities in which the situation is particularly critical.

Eligibility for regular FPFA housing was agreed upon by the Hon. H. M. Keim, Commissioner of the FPFA, and Dillon S. Meyer, Director of WRA, and it is expected to assist materially particularly as war work continues.

others working on contracts terminated by the war and now occupying the housing return to their former localities.

Permission to occupy a limited number of trailer and dormitory facilities was granted as an exception to an established rule prohibiting any further occupancy of these projects in order to provide some immediate temporary facilities for returning evacuees. Those people who move into these projects are expected to vacate them as permanent housing becomes available.

Despite this new eligibility for vacancies, housing remains tight in many West Coast areas. FPFA officials cautioned that evacuees probably would have to wait for their application on waiting lists and should be on hand to make applications.

North. Cal. Evacuees Have No Difficulties Obtaining Sales Tax Permits

SAN FRANCISCO. — Sales tax permits which must be obtained through the State Board of Equalization, have not been an obstacle for returnees entering the country from the North California Area, according to Otis Peterson, acting chief of the relocation Division.

An inquiry sent to the San Francisco office of the Board of Equalization by Peterson brought the reply that all previous cases have been permitted to open and there were no complaints or cases on hand at that time.

Japanese Cruelty Described by Nisei

Prisoners Used as 'Guinea Pigs' in Samurai Sword Practice

NEW YORK. Additional evidence of Japanese cruelty was supplied here by a Japanese who fought against the soldiers of Hirohito for sixteen months during the struggle for Burma.

Former S. Sgt. Henry H. Gosho, 25, the first Nisei soldier from the China-Burma India theater to reach this city, reported that Japanese troops training to become officers received special instruction in how to use their Samurai swords to behead prisoners without nicking their weapons. Chinese prisoners were used as "guinea pigs."

Recounting his experiences while serving with the "Merrill's Marauders" during the Burma campaign, the Nisei veteran said he had obtained his information while questioning Japanese prisoners officially. A captured enemy sergeant bragged that he was an instructor in "cutting the necks." According to this "instructor" the Samurai sword was reserved mostly for Chinese prisoners, but occasionally an Allied airman was beheaded.

Propaganda Broadcast

In addition to interviewing prisoners, the sergeant—an American by birth—broadcast Allied propaganda beamed at enemy troops. The sergeant said he had obtained his information while questioning Japanese prisoners officially. A captured enemy sergeant bragged that he was an instructor in "cutting the necks." According to this "instructor" the Samurai sword was reserved mostly for Chinese prisoners, but occasionally an Allied airman was beheaded.

CALIF. ATTORNEY GENERAL COMMENTS YOLO SHERIFF

SAN FRANCISCO. — The prompt and efficient manner in which Yolo County Sheriff Forrest D. Monroe disbursed a hostile crowd banding about a Japanese family at Winters, Calif., drew warm approval from California Attorney General Robert Kenny in a letter to the Yolo sheriff.

The incident involved two recently returned families at Winters, Calif. The families stopped at a grocery store for provisions and were threatened by a group which gathered outside the store. The sheriff answered a call for help by the store manager and used the usual logic and reason which threatens to maintain law and order.

The sheriff then escorted members of the families to the farm where they were to stay, although it was in Solano County and out of his jurisdiction.

Kenny's letter said in part: "I want you to know of my great pleasure over your speedy action in a crucial incident, which if it were not for your cool and intelligent judgment, might have led to a situation in which California would have been ashamed."

FRESNO. — Ejectment proceedings were filed last week by the State of California against two alien Japanese couples over ranch property in the Garretts and Sangre districts. The defendants are Kichisaburo and Tohgie Shibus and Sogataro and Kazuo Fujita. The two parcels approximate 100 acres.

William Shibuson of the Shibus couple and Suetien of the Fujita couple are the plaintiffs, a daughter of the other couple, also a citizen, are named co-defendants in separate actions.

It is alleged the aliens obtained title to the two parcels through subterfuge by having title in the name of the children and that the true ownership is being concealed.
