

## Nisei Veteran's Rejection By V.F.W. Starts New Group

SPOKANE, Wash. — The rejection of Pfc. Richard Natio, Seattle-born Japanese American, by a Spokane post of the Veterans of Foreign Wars was a minority action promptly disavowed by local and national V.F.W. officers. But out of the storm of protest has emerged a new organization of veterans who hope to establish chapters throughout the nation to fight discrimination. The Veterans' Committee for Equal Rights.

Fifty former committee members, now scattered throughout the country, have been asked to start organizing local chapters by legal action," declared Richard M. Ballin, executive secretary of the committee, said the organization "just grew" from an almost spontaneous beginning last spring. Its future, he concedes, is uncertain, but the foundations have been set for a permanent national organization with headquarters in Spokane.

The movement started when Natio, wounded veteran of the 442nd Infantry recuperating at the Baxter General Hospital here, was rejected for membership into a Spokane post of the V.F.W. A small group of fellow patients set up a loose organization, the Baxter hospital anti-prejudice league, and drafted a petition which emerged with the signature of 458 community residents and put the "Natio case" in newspapers throughout the world.

## Nisei Wins Damage Case

Jury of the County Court of Denver has returned a verdict in favor of a Nisei, Frank Kitada, and awarded him full damages for the loss of his automobile which was stolen from a parking station.

Frank Kitada, on his way to the theater with his friend, parked his Chevrolet, 1944 model, in the Auto Park. On returning to the parking lot, he found his car missing.

This case went to trial September 25th and continued to the 26th when it was submitted to the jury. The verdict of the jury in favor of Mr. Kitada ordered the Auto Park to pay for the loss. The case was presented by John Y. Manno as attorney for Mr. Kitada.

BRIGHTON — Visiting at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Kobayashi of this city is Pfc. Max Hada who has been undergoing treatment at Fitzsimmons Hospital in Denver since the end of June.

Hada volunteered for the army in February of 1944 and went overseas with the famed 442nd Infantry. He spent 18 months in Italy and France and was wounded twice while in combat there.

## Nisei Experts Ferrated Top Japanese Secrets for U.S.

TOKYO. — A highly secret U. S. Army unit made up principally of Japanese Americans operated so skillfully on Pacific battlefields that often it knew the telephone numbers of Japanese billets.

Existence of the organization was disclosed this week by Allied headquarters. Every document seized in combat by the unit's operatives, from periodicals and diaries to maps and carbon paper, was studied carefully by the Allied Translator and Interpreter Section—ATIS.

Among the Nisei in the ATIS were some taken of Corregidor before the fall of that island fortress. Many have been isolated for outstanding service.

"No group in the war had as much to lose," said the ATIS commander, Colonel Sidney M. Mashbir of Washington, D. C. "Capture would have meant indescribable horror to them and their relatives in Japan. They are worthy, as individuals and

as a group, of the highest possible praise for their available contribution to the success of Allied arms.

One Nisei soldier once asked Mashbir to be loaned from a rear echelon assignment to front-line duty. "He displayed this letter from his father:

"My son, I am dying. As you know, I have lived and am dying as a Japanese loyal to the emperor. You, on the other hand, were born in the United States and live up in the United States as an American. You are American. You have had all the advantages of education. On my deathbed, I command you to fight for the United States, and if need be to give your life for it."

"That boy won the Bronze Star," said Mashbir. "Fifteen others got the same award, two the Silver Star, one the Soldier's Medal, three the Purple Heart, and 40 received commendations. Of the first ten Nisei we received, three now are first lieutenants, and two are technical sergeants."

## Kido Declares Nisei Wanted Only As Cheap Labor

SALT LAKE CITY — Saburo Kido, national president of the JACL, declared last week as long as the Japanese "come in the status of cheap labor" they will be treated as such. Kido has no objections to that.

After dispatching telegrams to Secretary of War Robert Patterson and to the War Relocation Authority Command headquarters here objecting to the use of Japanese prisoners of war as agricultural laborers in California, Kido declared in a statement:

"It is apparent that west coast terrorists who recently have burned and shot down the homes of loyal American Japanese ancestry have no objections to the use of Japanese PWs in their status of cheap labor and as potential competitors."

Kido said Representative Eliot, Democrat of California, reported in Washington the decision to use Japanese PWs in his home area was reached after a survey indicated farmers had no prejudice against their use.

"On the other hand," continued Kido's statement, "efforts to find reemployment for returning Japanese Americans in the San Joaquin Valley have been met in some quarters with the statement that these Americans will not be welcomed."

## Federal Agencies Remove Japanese Employment Restrictions

WASHINGTON — With the end of the war, several Federal agencies have removed or modified their Japanese employment restrictions and procedures applying to the employment of other War Relocation Authority inmates.

Effective Sept. 2, 1945, Nisei are eligible for employment on vessels and waterfront facilities, subject to the same eligibility requirements as other U. S. citizens. The Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard, also has lifted orders excluding Nisei from access

to vessels and waterfront facilities.

Effective Sept. 14, 1945, the Civil Service Commission abolished all special procedures governing the Federal employment of Nisei. Appointments are now made under the usual procedures applicable to citizens, however. There is no change in Civil Service requirements requiring the clearance of Japanese and other enemy aliens.

Effective Sept. 13, 1945, the War Department removed all PWMO employment requirements for employment of Nisei in Army posts and establishments, unless it should be required of all persons applying for employment in military areas of the Western Defense Command.

The War Department has also rescinded its blanket order prohibiting persons of Japanese ancestry from being employed in any capacity at an airport or on an aircraft. Such persons may now secure armen identification cards in the same manner as other persons.

Effective Sept. 25, 1945, the War Department rescinded its orders requiring clearance of persons of Japanese ancestry for employment in plants working on Army contracts. However, plants classified as "secret," or similarly restricted, still require clearance of all prospective employees of any national or racial origin.
