Nothing in particular has happened lately, to me anyway! I've just loafed for so much and gained another ton, no doubt.

Pop put an add in the paper for house work and gardening! Boy! You should have seen the results. Really swell. One fellow came the first day! He wanted mamma to do the house work. He's a teacher at Uici Hi.

Lives 4 blocks south of piero between Overland and Manning! His name is Arthur Ramey. She works there on Tuesdays. The following evening a man came from 1900 Manning.

He wanted a gardener! Pop did his place for \$10.

The next day a man came from Kelton Ave. He wanted a houseworker and a gardener. Mom is going there 2 times a week on Monday and

fridays. Pop gets \$15. from this place. Mom is charging \$1. an hour. She already got pretty much. These people, Mr. & Mrs. Watt. have four sons. One was a marine, who was wounded in the arm. They had a friend who needed a gardener and a house worker. Mom and pop both went there. These people are musicians. The wife is an artist and plays the cello. He plays the piano and violin and is a Professor at U.C.L.A. Their name is Mr + Mrs. Abramovitch or something like that. They live at Duetna Green. Pop doesn't know if he'll work there because he's going to charge \$25.

Mom has work for 4 days with Sat. + Sun. off. Wednesday is the only day open for 1 more place.

Pop takes care of four places. He hasn't much to do yet. But still he keeps busy? He's getting old or something and he can't straighten his back like a board + claims his rear hurts! Getting old!

Mom says she will pay your fare to come back. She's really eager to have you back again. Gosh it's been a year, since we have seen each other.

When you come back, don't forget to bring your camera and ration points! We sure can use a lot of those red points! They are really precious aren't they!

A girl came to visit me. Really was swell to have her at our place. We ate lunch together and then she told me all about Manganaar. I think she went back in her father's car, today.

Mom and pop don't care to work at those old places any more. They won't be able to get a lot of money if they do!

Golly! Nothing to write about. Say! will you tell Joe to make it snappy with that camera! He sure is a liar. Says he'll send it right away and that was a month ago. I ought to go up to Minneapolis + kick him in the pants, give him a black eye and then throw him in the trash can! Ha ha ha!

See, this is a short letter but any thing will do so. I might as well send it to you.

Better quit! Please tell Joe that Jim is boiling up to the most highest temperature! Ha ha! As if I am!
