Saying bye now..

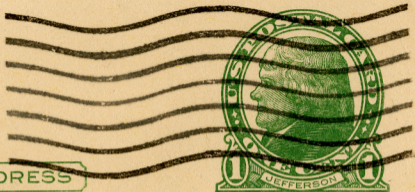
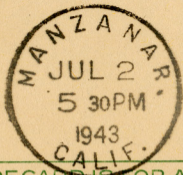
