Again this week mamma has gone to make funeral flowers. So I am all alone.

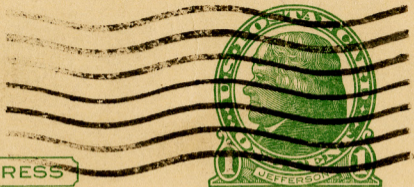
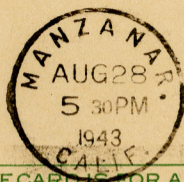
Last week mamma made me a new dress, a Cool Summer one. Boy I sure was glad. She also made 2 blouses & they are both made of cool material.
