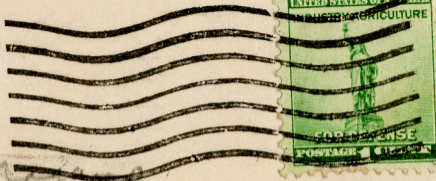
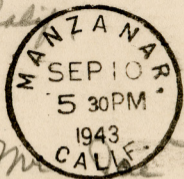


Dear Joe, I will be here not to Sept 10 1943
