full of dirt!

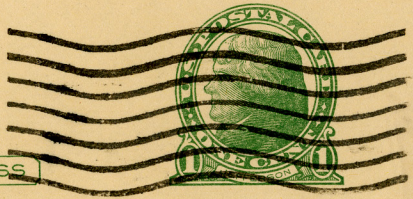
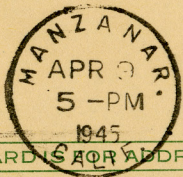
I went to church & saw
