This is Station X Y Z, of Apple,
Orchard. Pause 30 secs.

Music. (Any kind)

M.C.: ^{copy} "greeting, Lady ^{copy} & gentlemen, this is
your favorite radio program 'Oh
kitts, to you'. Welcome to our informal
gathering tonight. We are very fortunate
tonight. We have with us a disting-
uished member of the Cinema. She is?
I mean, she is Betty Cable. Applause.

M.C.: Our skit for tonight is "who
^{copy} done it?" or "should you have done it?"
Miss Cable will play the part of
Mrs. Upstein and Jack you play the part of
her mean little kid and I'll play
the part of Pop-up Stein, I mean Pop
Upstein.

Mr. C.: Our skit opens in Middleton,

Mrs. Upstein. Mrs. Upstein is spending
(amplitude decreased)
