


WAR RELOCATION AUTHORITY

CITIZEN'S INDEFINITE LEAVE

March 13, 1943

This is to certify that Hellen Tsuji*, a citizen of Japanese ancestry residing in Block No. 5406-E within Tule Lake Relocation Area is allowed to leave such area on March 13, 1943 and, subject to the terms of the regulations of the War Relocation Authority relating to issuance of leave for departure from a relocation area and subject to any special conditions or restrictions set forth on the reverse side hereof, to enjoy leave of indefinite duration. The holder's first destination is Corvallis, Montana.
