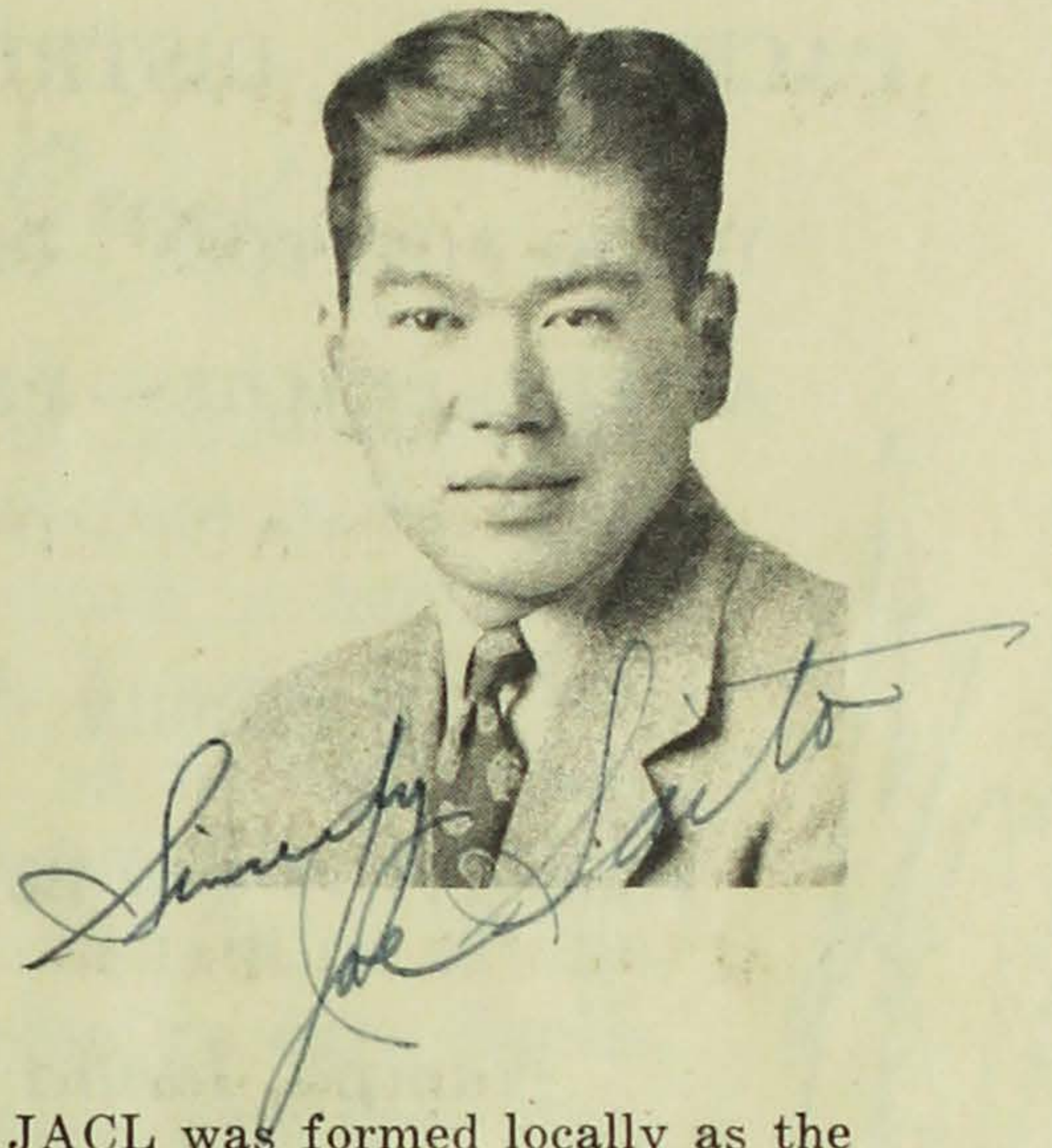
Greetings Delegates:

The embryo of the Boise Valley and Snake River Chapters of the JACL was formed locally as the Japanese American Citizens Club in Nampa, Idaho, in 1932, with 33 charter members. Yutaka Akichika, at present in Homedale, Idaho, presided at the organization meeting. Henry Suyehira of Emmett, Idaho, was elected the first president of the JACC.

Members of the organization resided in five counties in Idaho and Malheur County in Oregon, covering a territory of approximately 5,000 square miles. Some members drove over 100 miles to attend meetings.

Activities sponsored annually were a graduation banquet and dance, summer outing, dances and seasonal socials, and educational meetings.

"Reflections," the official organ of the Boise Valley Chapter, was first distributed by the JACC in 1938.

The area was divided into four districts: Nampa, Caldwell, Homedale, and Oregon side, in 1939. This was done to divide responsibility for activities and to get a better representation of all areas on the Executive Committee.

Affiliation with the Intermountain District Council of JACL came in 1942. Mrs. Martha Nishitani, Caldwell, was the president of the organization at that time.

Following the increase of population caused by evacuation, the Snake River Chapter was formed in 1944. Joe Komoto, Nyssa, Oregon, the first president, served two years in that office.

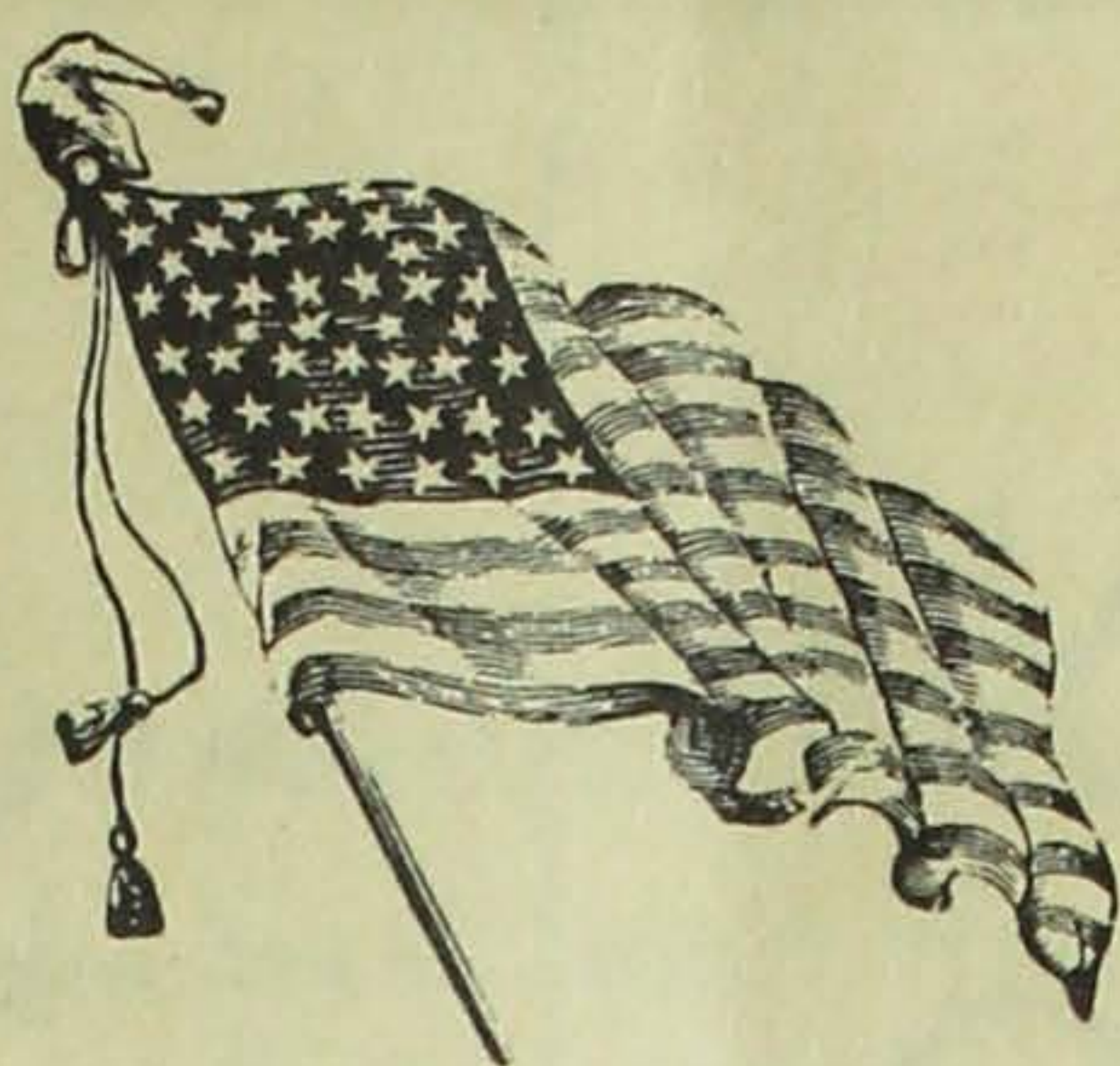

The Japanese American Creed

I am proud that I am an American citizen of Japanese ancestry, for my very background makes me appreciate more fully the wonderful advantages of this nation. I believe in her institutions, ideals, and traditions; I glory in her future. She has granted me liberties and opportunities such as no individual enjoys in this world today. She has given me education befitting kings. She has entrusted me with the responsibilities of the franchise. She has permitted me to build a home, to earn livelihood, to worship, think, speak, and act as I please—as a free man equal to every other man.

Although some individuals may discriminate against me, I shall never become bitter or lose faith, for I know that such persons are not representative of the majority of the American people. True, I shall do all in my power to discourage such practices, but I shall do it in the American way: aboveboard, in the open, through courts of law, by education, by proving myself to be worthy of equal treatment and consideration. I am firm in my belief that American sportsmanship and attitudes of fair play will judge citizenship and patriotism on the basis of action and achievement, and not on the basis of physical characteristics.

Because I believe in America and I trust she believes in me, and because I have received innumerable benefits from her, I pledge myself to do honor to her at all times and in all places; to support her constitution; to obey her laws; to respect her flag; to defend her against all enemies, foreign or domestic; to actively assume my duties and obligations as a citizen, cheerfully and without any reservations whatsoever, in the hope that I may become a better American in a greater America.

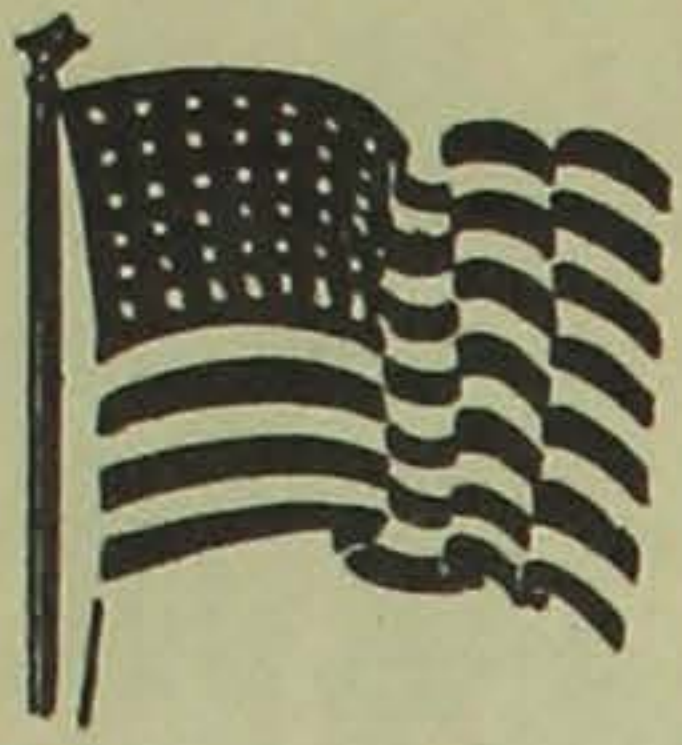

It is our great pleasure to welcome as guest speaker at our Second Biennial Intermountain District Convention, Samuel P. Weaver, A.B., M.A., LL.B., C.L.U., Litt. D., LL.D.

He is one of very few men to win distinction in four fields of endeavor, being listed in "Who's Who in Insurance," "Who's Who in Law," "Who's Who in Industry," and in "Who's Who in America."

Samuel P. Weaver was born in 1882 on a farm in Pennsylvania, and his career has been one of success won in the hard way. He was responsible for his own education, winning his way through Gettysburg College in 1904. He immediately entered the University of Michigan, where he acted as general agent for the Aluminum Cooking Utensil Company, and served as the manager of the students' cooperative store. He received the degree of LL.B. in 1907. In 1940 he received the degree of LL.D. from Gonzaga University. In 1941, his photograph was hung in the Law Library of the University of Washington to remain permanently with the photographs of other distinguished lawyers and jurists of the State of Washington. These recognitions have come to him as a result of a long and successful career as a student, lawyer, teacher and business man.

His personal achievements of hard-won success and recognition, together with his accurate knowledge of America today, make him especially fitted to bring us a most important and inspiring message in our program to "Finish the Fight."

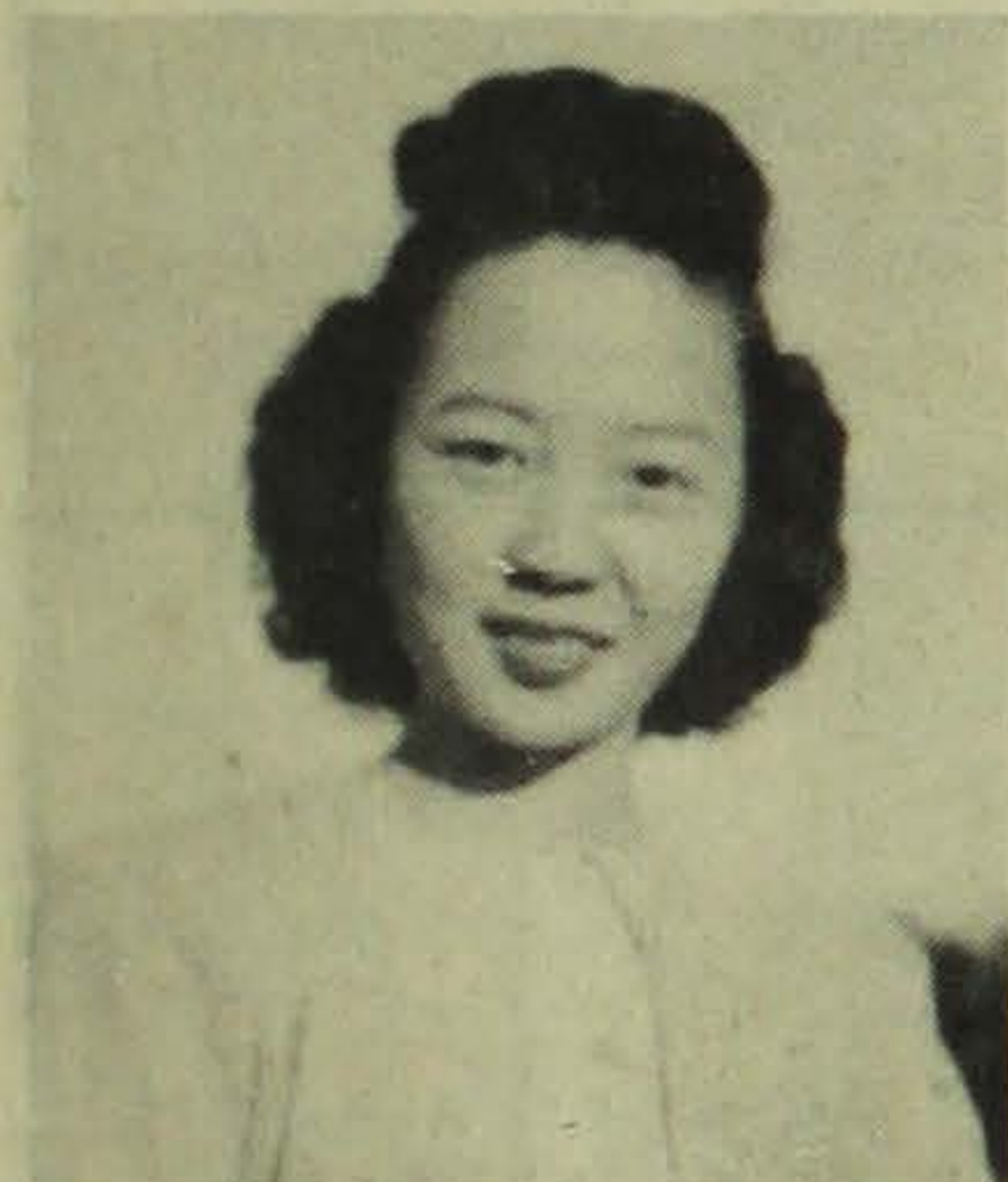

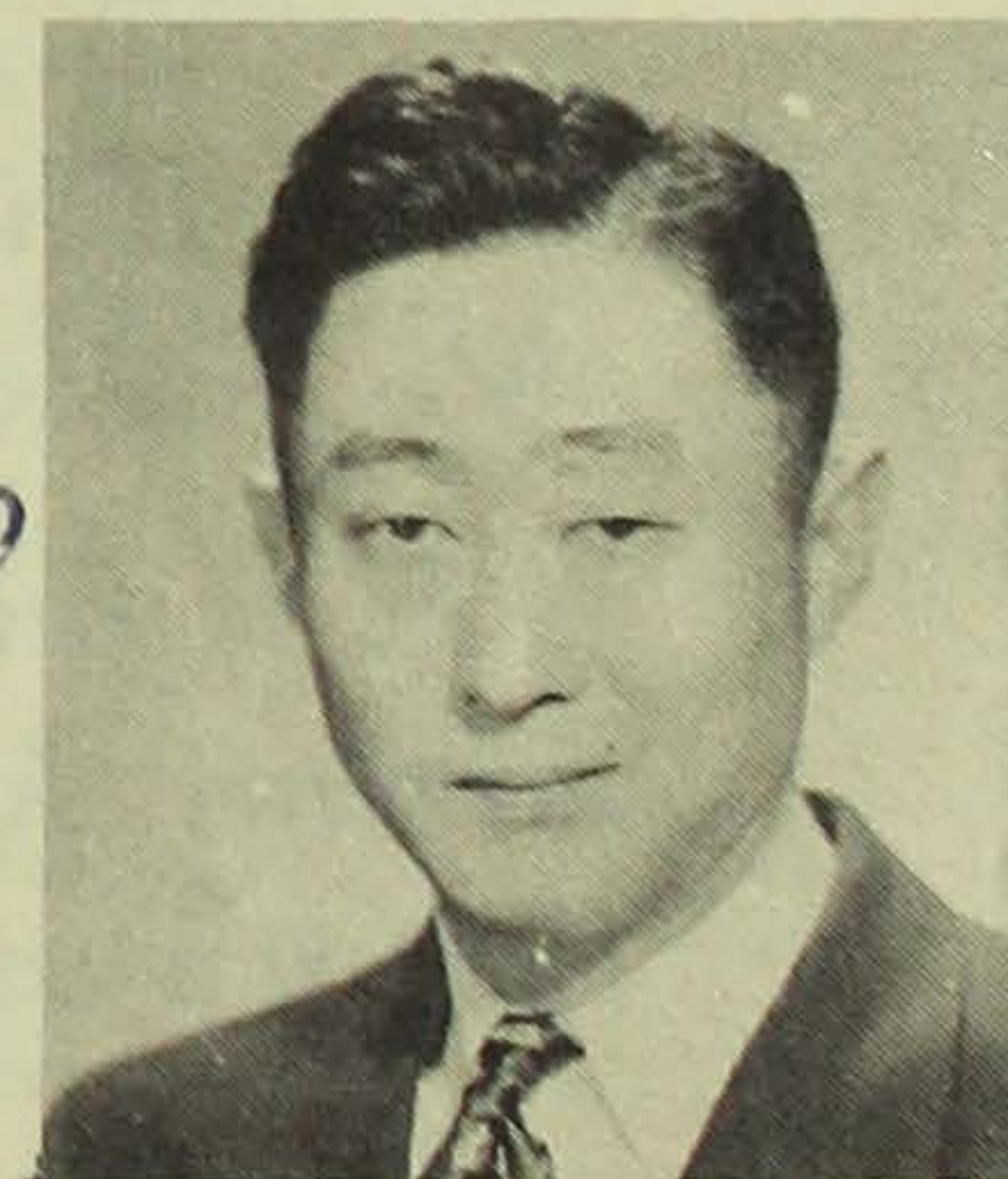

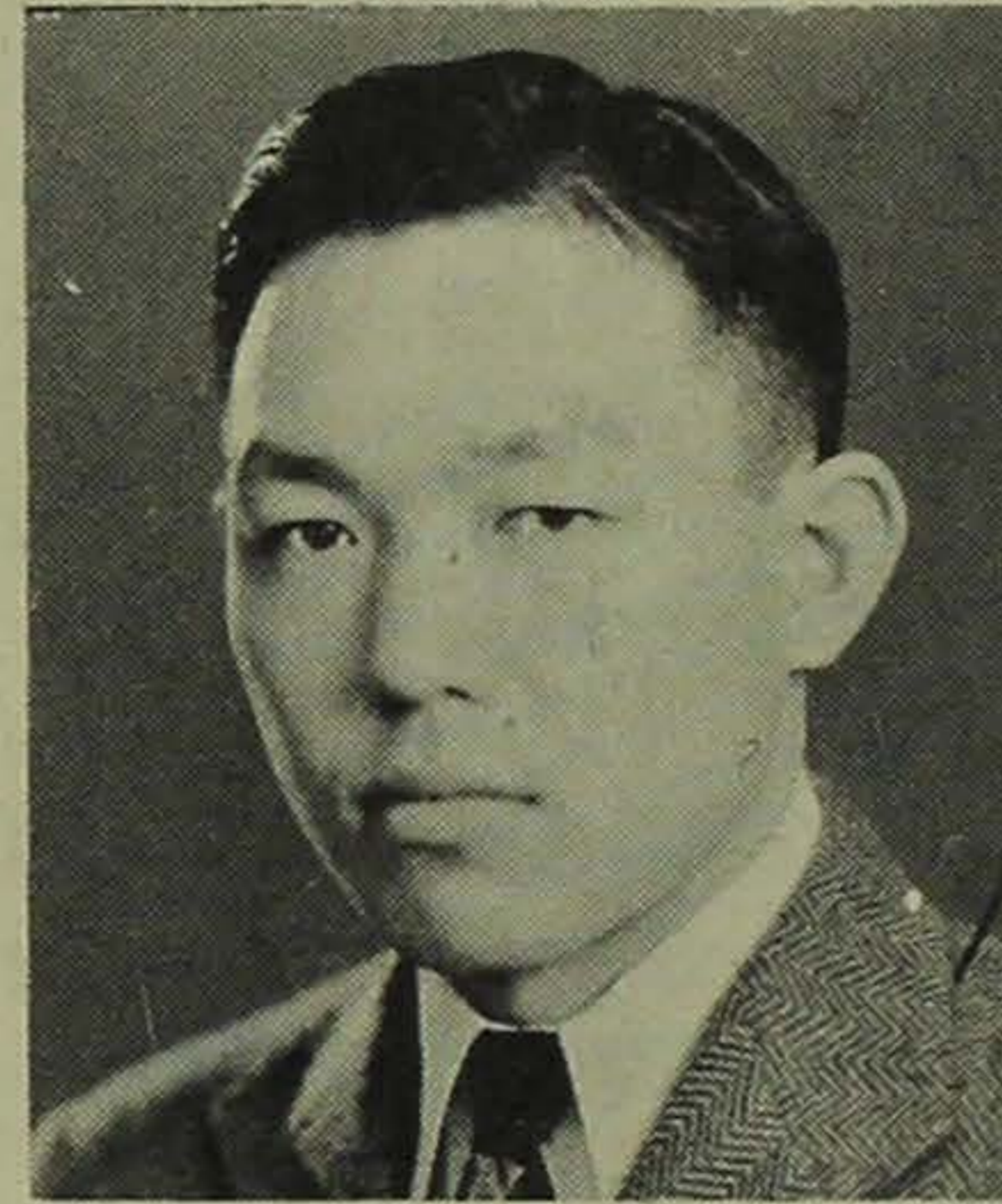
