How's every thing with you folks? We're just fine

Well, we got the truck that Thurs. nite. Everything I asked for was on the box truck. Refrigerator, range, sawerport, radio, chest and even ~~some~~^{more} old love letters.

I sold the range I bought ~~of~~ from gun Tanaka with some profits, \$165 and I still have the ~~the~~^{18'} cable wire which is worth quite a bit.

Enclosed is a letter from my boss which you could take ~~it~~ to the leavena office

and apply for your season
pass right away by Sunday
May 14th I'll be in for
you there. Getting pretty
busy out here and he ~~is~~
want some help right away
I'm working from 6:30 to 8
some times 9 P.M. at night. Now
I'm driving tractor ~~day~~ day after
day plowing. He says he'll
pay \$6⁰⁰ a day guaranteed. If
he hasn't any work for you
on his farm he'll send
you to another farm near
~~the~~ the new one and talk
to some other farmers this
morning who says will of use
you. Be ready to come home
with us this Sunday. I see
your ration book too.
