Dear Mr. Clore:

We have received Standard Form 1055 covering claim of Hatsune Yoshida for the proceeds of salary of \$3.75 due her husband, Dave Kyugi Yoshida, on December 20, 1942, the date of his death. This claim was forwarded to this office by the National Office of the War Relocation Authority.
