Masao Yamashita was appointed to secure the judges for the oratorical which was to have been held on Friday, June eleventh.


Walter Tatsumi, song chairman, asked that the songs be turned in as soon as possible so they may be tried out at the picnic.

A report on the Northwest Board meeting at Hood River was given by Thomas Iseri concerning the legislative fund.


A motion was made and passed to send five dollars to Yakima for program on convention, as each chapter was asked to
