

SIXTY-FIFTH--MEETING
VALLEY CIVIC LEAGUE

January 21, 1938



Charles Toshi, first vice-president, presided in the absence of the newly elected president.


A motion was made and seconded that we make the Installation Banquet an annual affair. This year's to be a dinner-dance social. Mike Iseri was appointed chairman for this affair.
