The treasurer reported that we have a balance of \$45.03.

Suggestion by Thos. Iseri that the league invest their savings (amounting to \$418.13) in government bonds. Motion made and seconded that a committee be appointed to inquire into the matter. Those appointed on the committee are as follows: Tom Iseri, Frank Natsuhara and Tomio Itabashi.

New members were introduced; they are as follows: Ted Takeshita, Kay Okuda and Mary Watanabe.

The president appointed Carolyn Kaji as correspondent
for the Pacific Citizen.
